What is this report about?

This report tells you what we found when we looked at Community Services that people use and how well they can use them.

We looked at:

- How easy it is to get to places.
- If the information they have is easy to understand.
- Their customer service skills.
- What special equipment there is.



People with disabilities are more likely to have health conditions.

Because of this, people with disabilties can have an Annual Health Check.

This is a health check-up that you can get at your Doctors once a year.

For this report we looked at:

- How many people had an Annual Health Check.
- How easy it is for people to use services in the community that can keep them healthy.



What did we find out?

We found that:

- There are not many people who have had an Annual Health Check in Stockton.
- We think that there needs to be a way to make sure Annual Health Checks are done well
- Someone needs to be in charge of this work.



When we looked at community services we found that:

- More places need to be aware about the needs of disabled people.
- More people with Disabilities need to know about the Safe Place Scheme. Safe Places are places in the community you can go to if you need help.
- Public transport needs to be easier to use for people with different needs.

We found that getting services right for people with a Learning Disability or Autism would mean that we are getting it right for lots of other people too.



What will we do?

We want to make sure that more people can have Annual Health Checks.

We will do this by:

- Giving GP Practices more information
- Telling GP Practices how others are doing it well.
- Work with GP Practices to tell them where they are going wrong.
- Make sure someone who works at the GP Practice is in charge of this work.

We will also:

Make sure that more services talk to each other about people who have Learning Disabilities or Autism so they know who might need more support.



We also want to make sure more people with a Learning Disability or Autism can use community services.

We will do this by:

Telling community services what is expected of them.

Make sure that people who work in the Council have Learning Disability and Autism training.

Make public transport easier to use for people with different needs by giving transport companies more information.

Look at the work that the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) do to check the support they give to people with a Learning Disability or Autism.

Make sure more people know about the Safe Place scheme.

Support the Police and Community Safety team to stop Hate Crime.

Look at making personal care and changing rooms in the community for people who have complex needs better.

Words and terms used in this report:



Community Services:

Community services are public places that you go to near where you live. They could be council services, community centres, leisure centres, libraries etc.



GP Practice:

GP Practice is a name for the place where your Doctor works.



Department for Work and Pensions:

The department for work and pensions is in charge of benefits payments. It might also be called the DWP.



Hate Crime:

Hate crime is any crime that has happened to someone because of their: disability, gender, age, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation or gender identity.



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
