Care Quality Commission (CQC) Inspection Outcomes – Quarter 2 2017-18

The CQC is the national inspectorate for registered health and adult care services. Inspection reports are regularly produced and these are published on a weekly basis.

The CQC assesses and rates services as being 'Outstanding', 'Good', 'Requires Improvement', or 'Inadequate'. Where providers are found to be in need of improvement or inadequate, the CQC make recommendations for improvement and / or enforcement action. Specific actions taken in each case can be found in the relevant inspection report.

Where inspections are relevant to the Borough, a summary of the outcome is circulated to all Members each week. If a report is negative, an update from Adult Services is included which summarises the position in relation to service provision and any actions taken at that time.

On 14 September 2015, it was agreed that the Committee would receive a quarterly roundup of recent reports. These would be aligned with the Six-monthly Adult Performance Reports where possible.

Recent Reports

This update includes inspection reports from July to September 2017 inclusive.

Between 1 April and 30 June 2017 there were twelve reports published. Please note: there is a time lag between dates of the inspection and the publication of the report. In addition, where concerns are identified by CQC, re-inspections may take place soon after the initial report is published. When the outcomes are made available within the same quarter, the result of the most recent report is included in this update.

The main outcome from the reports are as follows:

- eleven Adult Care services were reported on (four rated as Good [including the SBC-managed Reablement Service], seven rated as Requires Improvement);
- no reports were released on Primary Medical Care;
- -one report on Hospital/Other Health Care (rated as Good).

- The registered manager carried out regular checks to monitor and improve the quality of the service; however the checks had not highlighted the concerns with records
- Records were not always up to date to reflect people's current needs, were incorrectly completed, not dated, or unavailable
