Report recommended the Five Lamps pilot needs to run for a longer time period in order for the objectives to be delivered and robustly evaluated.</p> <p>Five Lamps pilot therefore extended by 2 years in order to create sufficient time for the service to be delivered and the objectives of the pilot tested.</p> <p>Five Lamps also awarded a separate contract to deliver the Discharge to Assess Services for a period of 1 year funded by BCF. Service provides rapid homecare for residents discharged from hospital or Rosedale for a maximum of 14 days during which time a Care Act Assessment can be carried out.</p>	2 – On Track	<p>Five Lamps continue to deliver Care at Home services to approx. 67 service users.</p> <p>Five Lamps have commenced a pilot lunch club open to their service users who would otherwise receive lunch in their own homes. The objective of the pilot is to test whether a lunch club reduces isolation and loneliness and can be operated sustainably within the current fee structure.</p> <p>Five Lamps continue to provide the Discharge to Assess Service and have received 164 referrals between beginning of April 2018 and end of January 2019.</p>	1 - Achieved
