Time Out Service

- Up to 8 hours per month free support for the carer to have a break form their caring role
- No domiciliary care
- Ad hoc support for the carer to ensure they can continue in their caring role

Carers Emergency Card



What is a carers emergency card?

- Each with a carers contingency planning document
- Line covered 24 hours a day 7 days per week
- Plans to link the card to track care to support with emergency admissions



Support with Hospital Discharge

- Information and signposting
- Provision of Carers Information packs
- Links with VCSE organisations
- Experience of carers when the cared for is admitted/discharged
- Experience of the carers when they themselves are admitted/discharged



Links with Hospital
