SCRUTINY REVIEW OF CARE AT HOME

Summary

This fourth, and last, evidence-gathering session for the review of Care at Home will involve contributions from Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council (SBC) officers, as well as a view from the Care Quality Commission (CQC).

 - > Future CQC inspection plans for Care at Home providers
 - CQCs thoughts on the impact to the sector of the new Integrated Care System (ICS) arrangements
