Apologies for the slow response.

We now have a policy whereby we will object to the implementation of any full length road hump, so the basic answer to the question is yes we would object. Whilst I appreciate the service level on the Service 20 is not the highest, the damage that the humps can cause to our vehicles and potentially our passengers cannot be underestimated. Should such a scheme be implemented one inevitable potential outcome would be the decision on whether we serve a particular location which would be a shame given that we are almost at a solution for the new shape of the Service.
