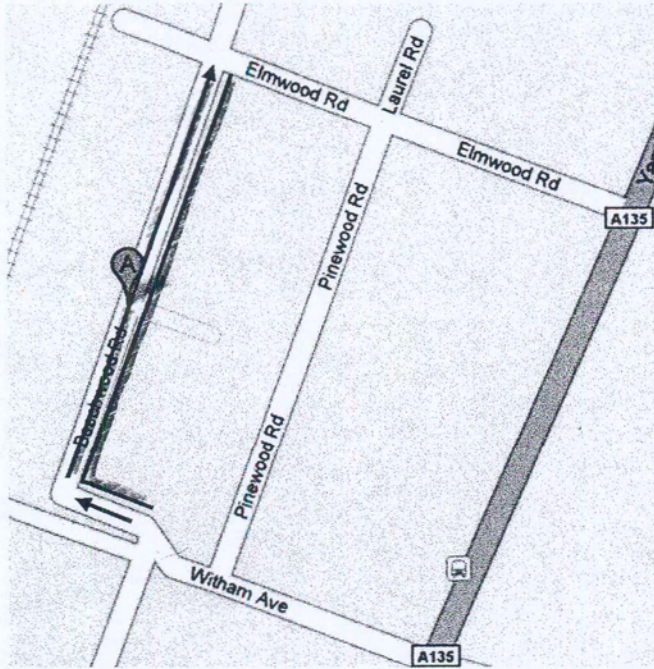
I am writing to you with regards to the proposal of introducing 24-hour waiting restrictions on the corner of Beechwood Road/Witham Avenue.

From my understanding the council is proposing to make it a no parking area. I object strongly to this. I have lived at 1 Beechwood Road for over 15 years. In this period there has not been an accident from my recollection that has been caused due to parking on the road. The area is essential for parking for our family and neighbours. We do not have a drive or garage to park our cars so the only safe place is outside our home. This proposal would take the security away from our vehicles as we may have to park several houses away or in neighbouring streets and not be able to keep an eye on our vehicles.

If the restriction is placed on parking in this area it would make it particularly difficult to find parking on Beechwood Road as it already extremely full of other resident's cars. This proposal will damage the community relations causing unrest among residents of Beechwood Road due to parking issues that would arise among the neighbours. There currently is not enough parking for all residents on Beechwood Road with some residents having to park on Witham Avenue.

I feel that this proposal has no merit, the road has not changed and neither has the environment surrounding the area to warrant a change to creating a 24-hour waiting restriction in this area. However if the issue of safety is the main reason for proposing this change, I would recommend that the council consider making the debated area a one-way system and this would allow for parking, whilst also solving the issue of safety as no on coming vehicles would cause a problem. Below is a map with red arrows highlighting where I propose the one-way system to be put in place.

PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS – BEECHWOOD ROAD / WITHAM AVENUE, EAGLESCLIFFE.

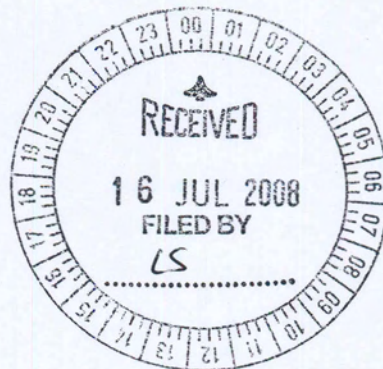
I refer to your letter dated 11 June 2008 in relation to the above proposals and your objections to them.

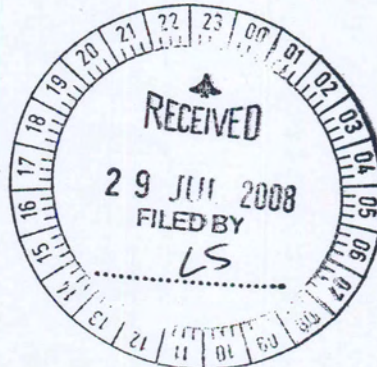

STOCKTON ON TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL (WITHAM AVENUE / BEECHWOOD ROAD, EAGLESCLIFFE, STOCKTON ON TEES) (24 HOUR WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2008

I am writing in reply to your objection to the above draft Order as recently advertised which has been formally received by the legal department. As you are aware from the initial consultation exercise the background to the proposal relates to parking around the 90 degree bend at the Beechwood Road / Witham Avenue junction which forces vehicles onto the wrong side of the road and into the path of oncoming traffic.

The extent of the originally proposed restrictions has been reduced by approximately 21 metres as a result of the consultation. The new extent of the restriction is what has been advertised, a copy of the original and revised proposals are enclosed for your information. The reduced extent is to accommodate some parking on the south side, parking is thereby permitted 17 metres from your property on the south side of Witham Avenue.

I note your request for a one way system. However, if a one way system was introduced it may result in increased vehicle speeds along Beechwood Road since drivers would be confident they would not meet, or need to give way, to oncoming traffic. It would also inconvenience residents in accessing their properties via a one way system as it may not be the most direct route. This could then lead to people contravening the one-way and result in enforcement issues for Cleveland Police.

There have been no reported injury accidents in the past three year period, the proposal is in response to road safety concerns, and has the support of the emergency services.

To implement waiting restrictions, a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) is required. As you have responded to the statutory advertisement within the objection period, the next stage is to ask you to consider your objection. If you wish your objections to stand the item will be referred to the Councils Appeals and Complaints Committee for consideration.


