I have noticed your intentions of installing speed restrictions to Wallington Road High Grange Billingham- between Marshhouse Ave & Longfellow Road.

I object to this traffic calming- most likely instigated by a minority of residents.

I presume some sort of survey has been carried out by yourselves & you have independent evidence of this speeding, I have resided in Wallington Rd since 1973 there has ONE road incident involving ONE vehicle due to excessive speed in 1976 there were no injuries.

I have spoken extensively to other residents on the road &not one has requested traffic calming measures, personally I think they are counter-productive as they generate speeding between the restrictive humps---- heavy braking & acceleration.

Degeneration of these raised humps is rapid they break up very quickly from ice damage- require constant maintenance & soon will have our road looking run down.

I don"t deny that I have in past witnessed speeding very very occasionally but then that's indicative of every estate in the country!!! Speed humps in this road are not warranted &will be an unnecessary expense on our council tax---- far better impose a 20 MPH limit on estate spine roads.

Finally I would be very interested to know just how many requests have been received by your department regarding traffic calming in Wallington Road?
