Buchanan Street - Off Street Car Parking (behind Wentane Motors)

We have seen the notice advising of the proposal to restrict parking in this car park to a period of two hours and wish to register a protest against this.

There is now, following recent changes, ample parking in this area that is for "up to two hours" and it is clear from our observations that this is not being fully utilised.

What there clearly is a shortage of, is long-term parking particularly for those who work in this area. The pay and display car parks in Brunswick Street are already full to capacity and many street parking areas are restricted to residents only or two hours. If this particular car park does change to two hours only, then the alternatives appear very limited and it seems that the council is trying to drive businesses out of Stockton.
