REASONS FOR DECISION: In 2011 a Borough wide parking study was undertaken. Norton was identified as an area for assessment. The Central Area Transport Strategy (ATS) Group whose members are local transport stakeholders have been given an annual budget allocation to spend on transport priorities in their particular area. Stakeholders include Ward Councillors and Norton Village Residents Association. The Central ATS Group approved a study into parking in Norton given the perceived parking issues in the area and to investigate the feasibility of introducing pedestrian crossing facilities at Leven Road. <u>Report/background Papers (matters which are not exempt or confidential):</u> Report TS.T.80.13 refers.
