EIT Gateway Review of Adult Operations

Summary

The Committee are asked to consider, comment upon, and challenge the baseline information that has been provided by the officer project team that is undertaking the review of Adult Operations.

Detail

- A number of scrutiny reviews are taking place in relation to the Council's Efficiency, Improvement and Transformation (EIT) process. Arts, Leisure and Culture Select Committee have been allocated three Gateway reviews. These are Adult Operations, Highways, lighting and network management, and Property and Facilities Management.
- 4. Gateway reviews are officer-led, however the Committee's role will be to receive information at two key stages in order to conduct further challenge. Copies of the baseline/challenge information for each review will be received by the Committee. This will be followed by the options that have been selected by the officer project team.
- 5. The baseline information for the Adult Operations review is now ready to be submitted to the Committee, along with what the project team have identified as the order of priority for review:
 - Day Care Services
 - Residential Care Home Services
 - In-House Home Care Services
 - Intermediate Home Care Services
 - Independent Provision of Home Care Services
- 6. The Adult Operations review is in effect split into these five areas of service provision, and therefore baseline information has been provided separately on each. These reports are attached.
- 7. For this review, the Committee will receive the selected options for change at the meeting on 15 February 2010 (as agreed at the meeting on 3 June).
