## Stockton Skate Park - Outline Programme

- 1. Due to the size and nature of the skatepark equipment, it is proposed that the skatepark facility currently provided at Stockton Sports Centre be relocated to Arlington Park. This will be a static site provision in addition to the mobile facilities being delivered across the Borough.
- 2. There is an ongoing commitment to provide a skatepark facility in Tilery and it is intended to utilise the land on which the sports centre is currently sited to deliver programmed events using the Sunramp mobile equipment.
- 3. Details in relation to skateboarding activities are provided below, based on current activities (attached) together with an outline programme.

3. The siting of the skatepark at outreach venues has been subject to a borough-wide survey to identify suitable sites and these have been fully risk assessed. Sites need to have a flat, suitable surface, be large enough to host the park, be accessible and have toilet facilities etc.
