



Performance Comparisons







Comments: The provisional results for 2006-07 school year represent a significant improvement (over half a percentage point) from last years figure. Medical reasons account for the highest proportion of absence (equivalent to 403 pupils absent for a year). Holidays taken in term time accounted for the equivalent of 156 pupils absent for a year. Both medical and holiday absence reduced from the previous year.
