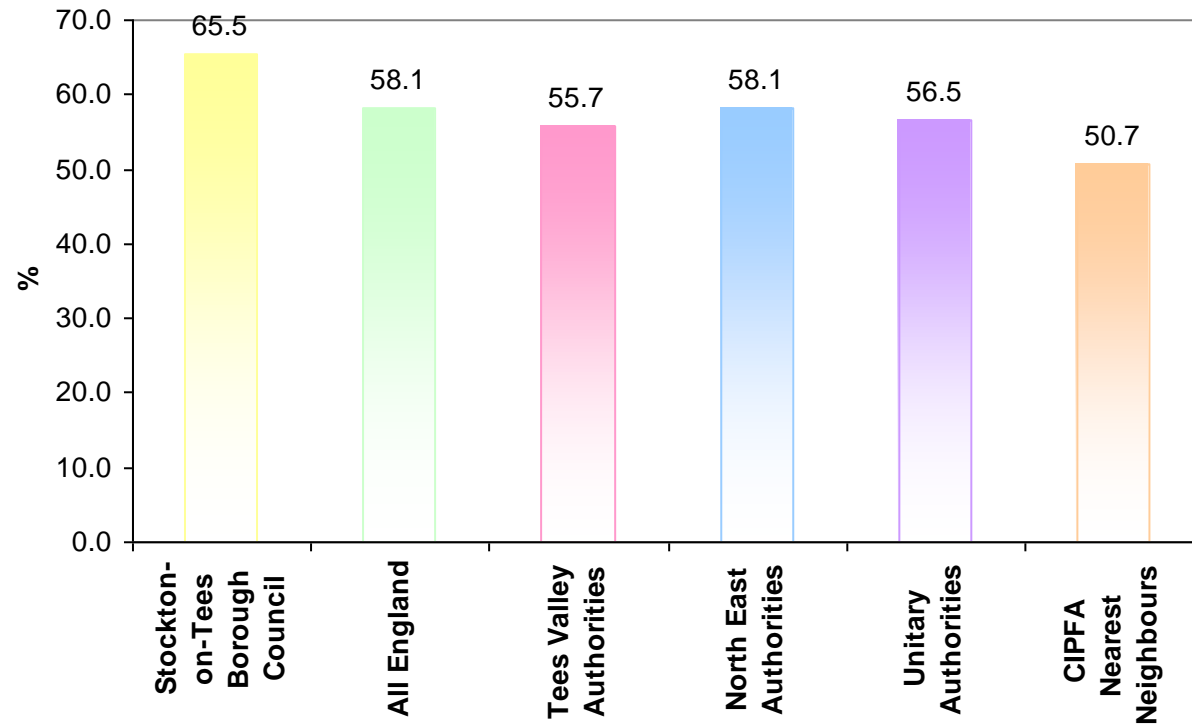

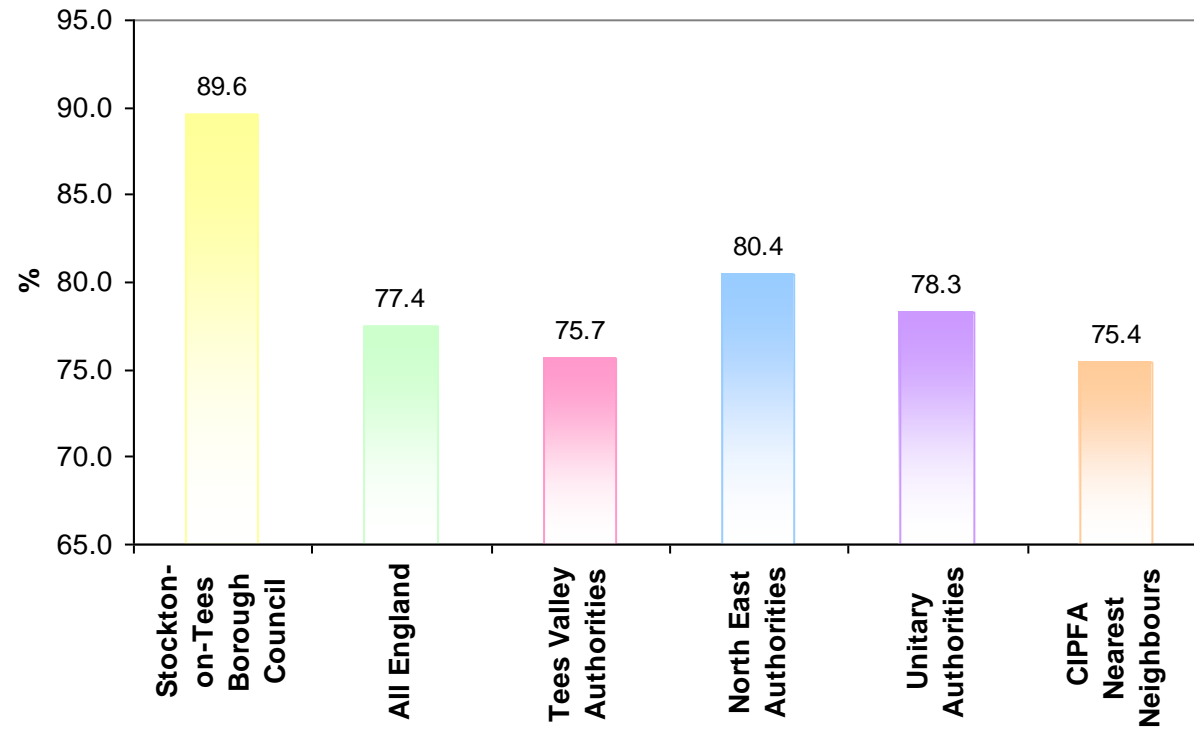

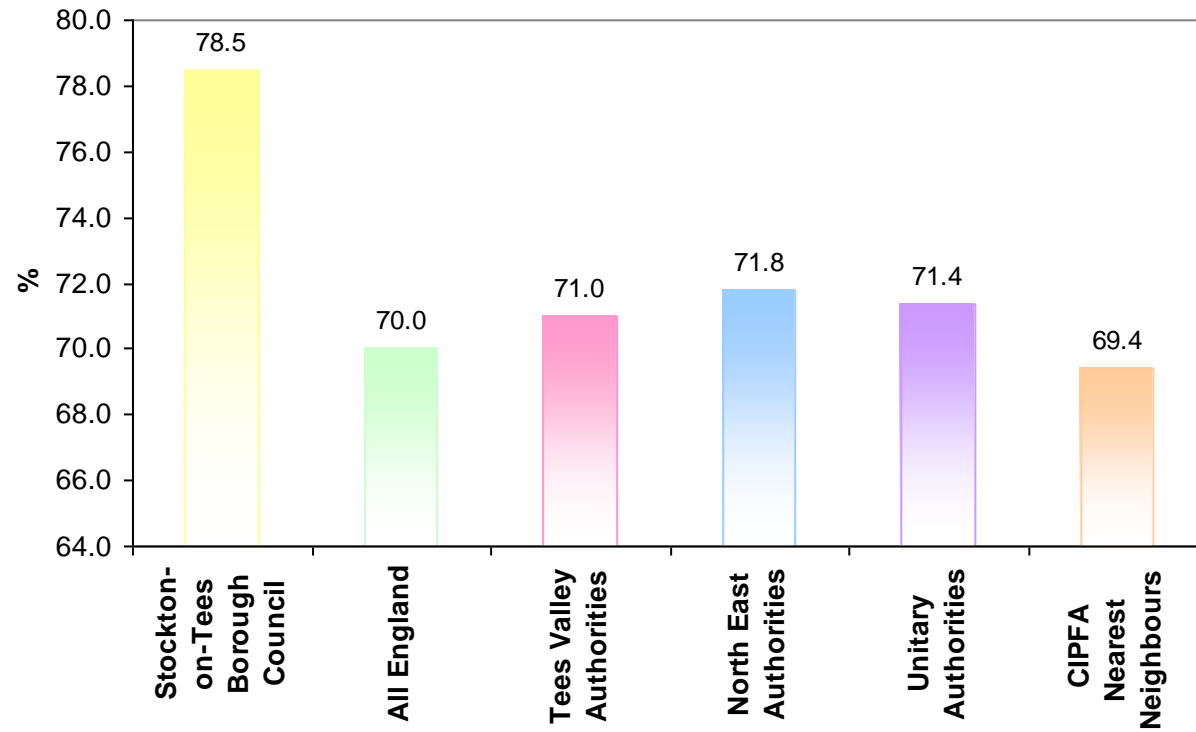
Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Work to Keep Public Land Clear of Litter and Refuse



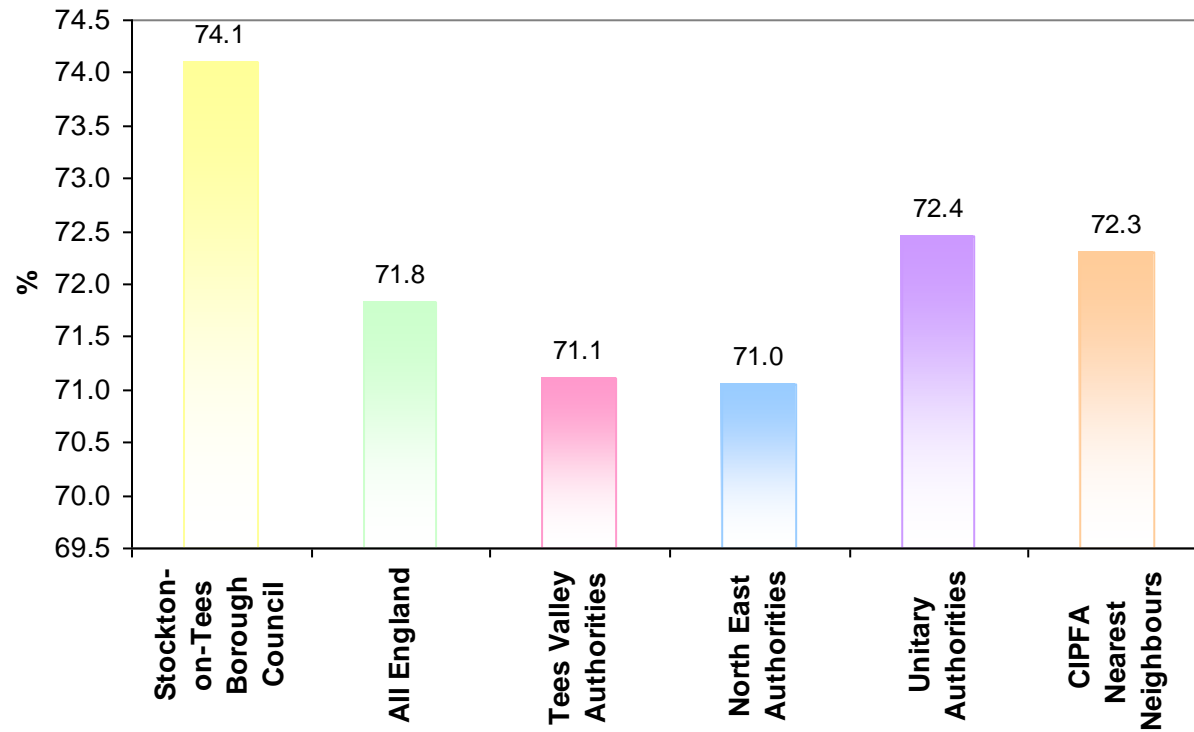
Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Refuse Collection Services



Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Doorstep Recycling Services

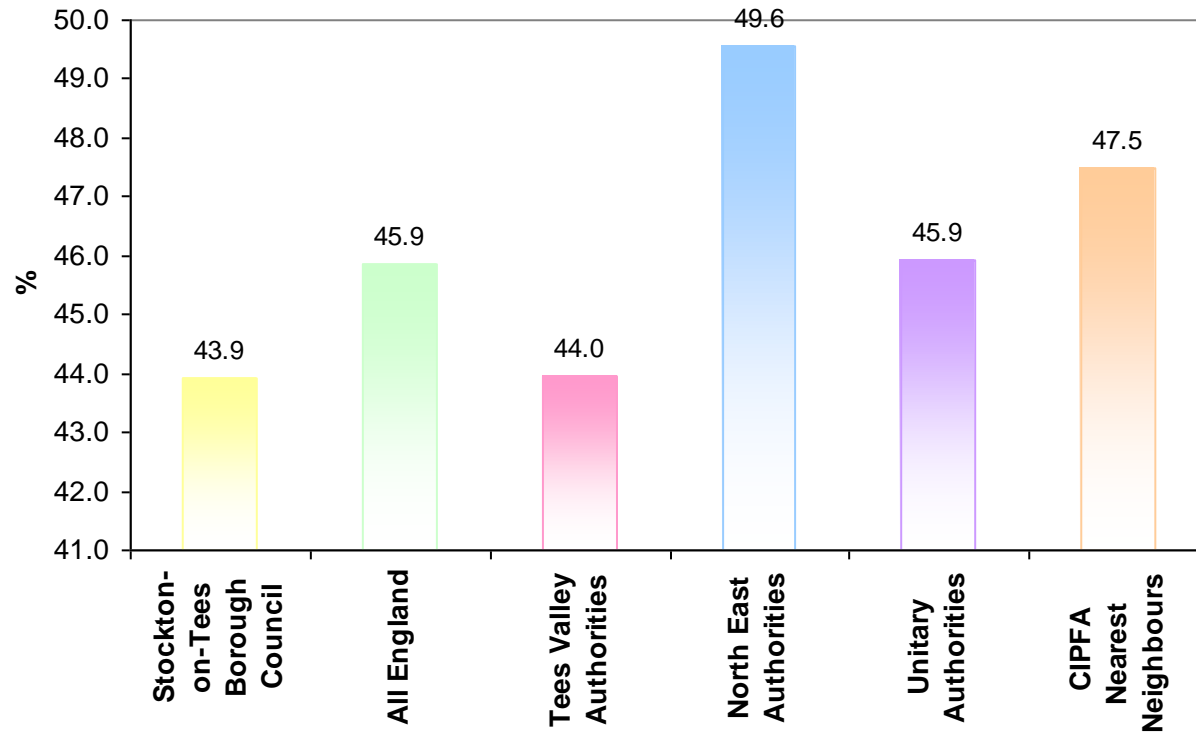


Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Local Tips / Household Waste Recycling Centres

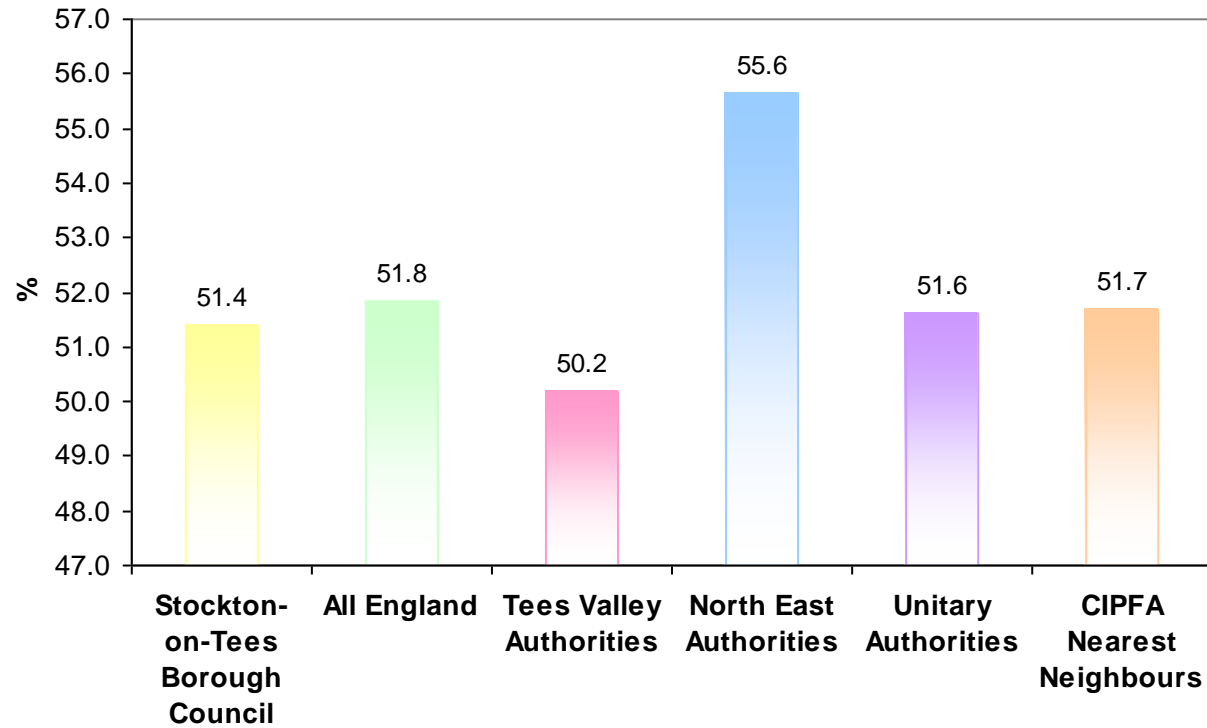

Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Local Transport Information

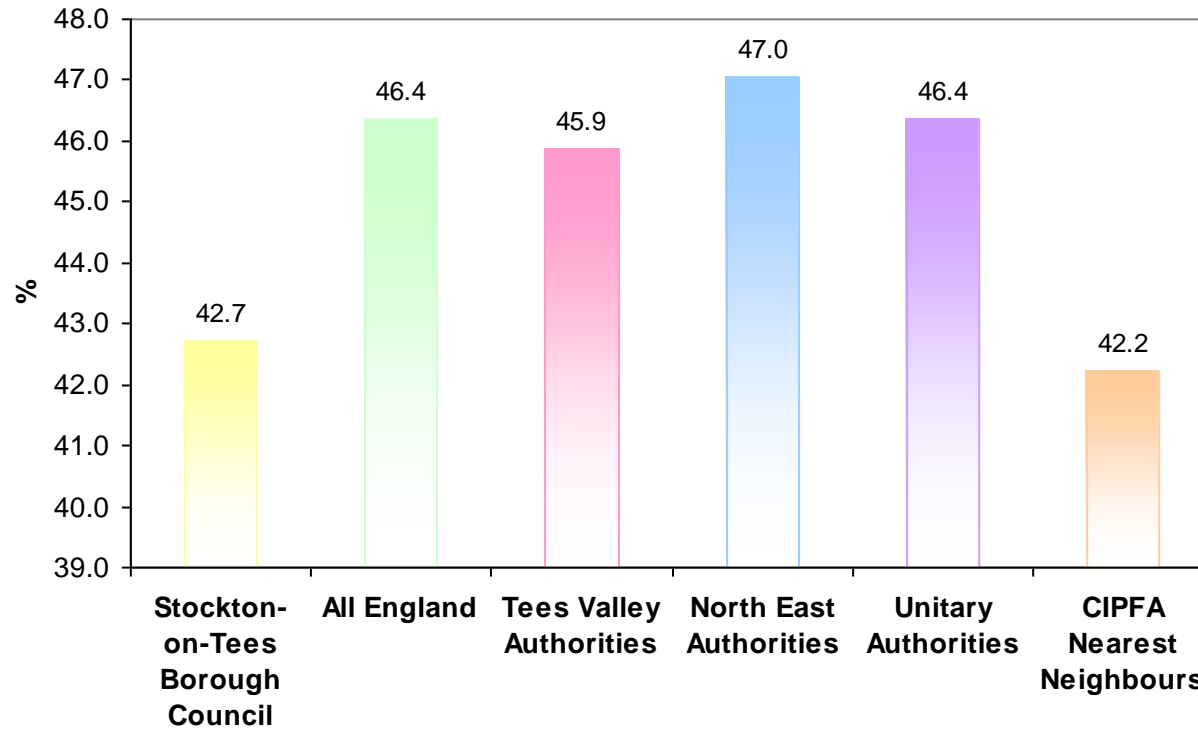


Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority's Local Bus Services

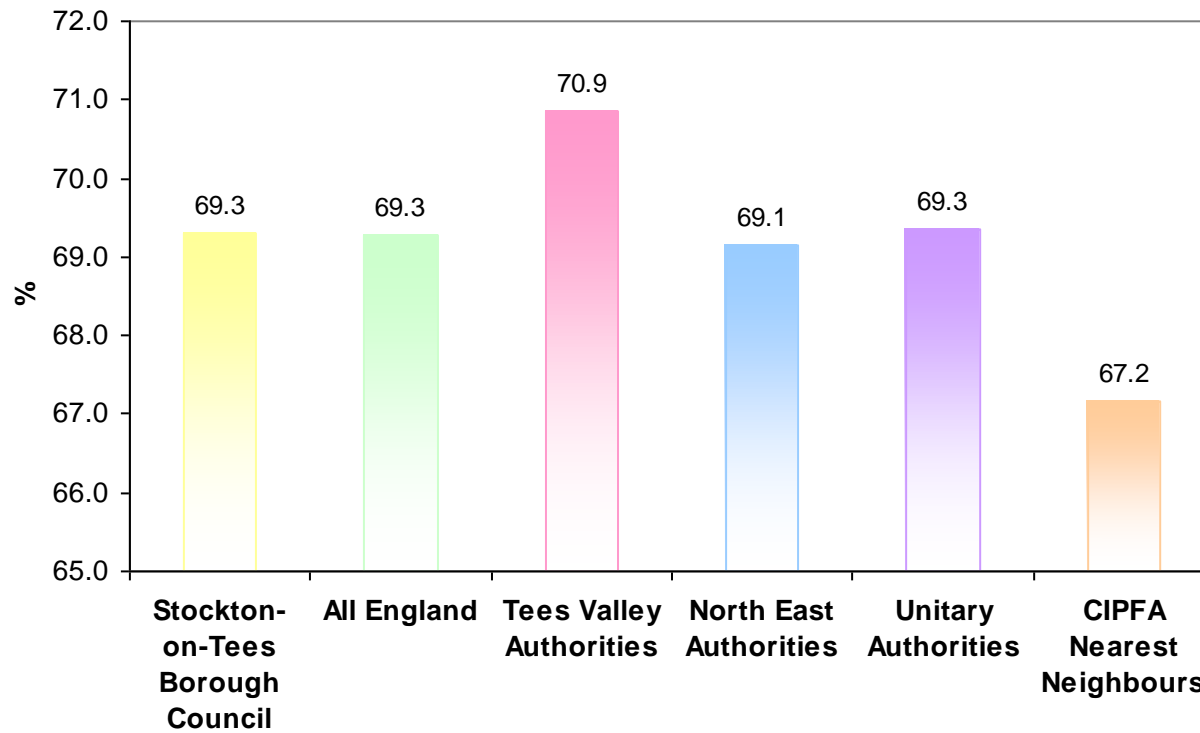

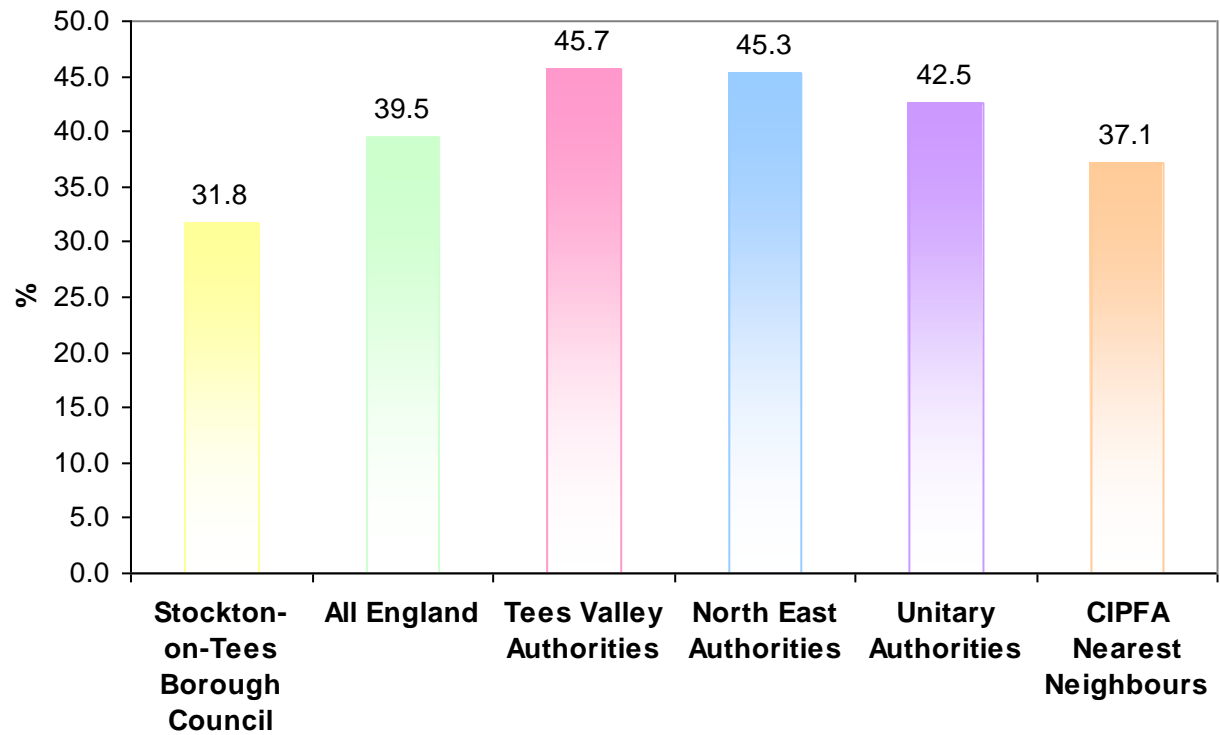
Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority Provided Sport / Leisure Facilities



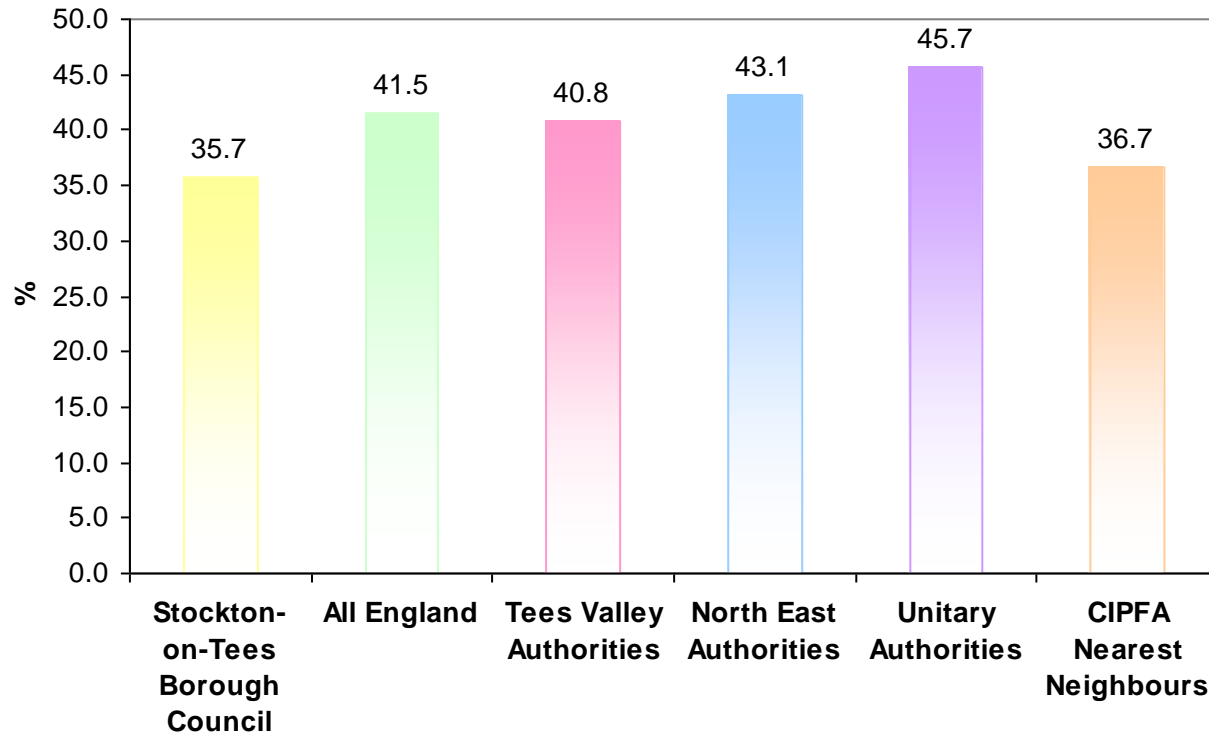
Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Libraries



Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority Provided Museums / Galleries

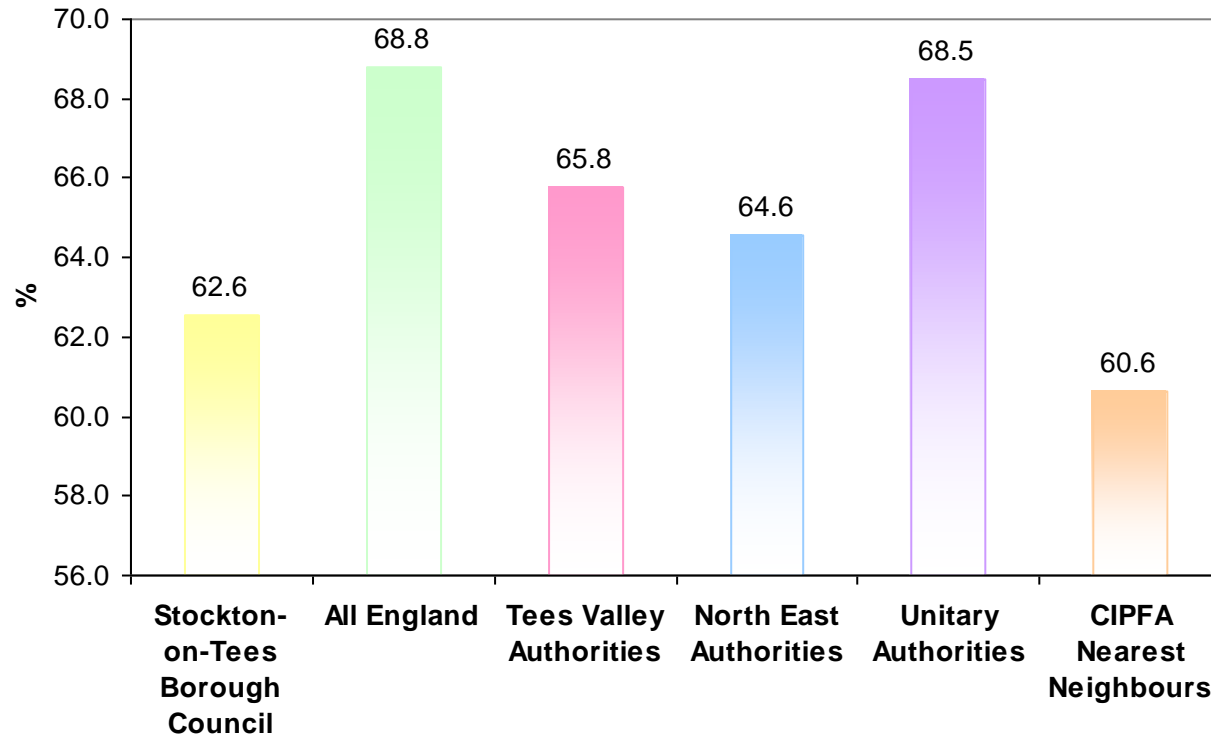


Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority Provided Theatres / Concert Halls



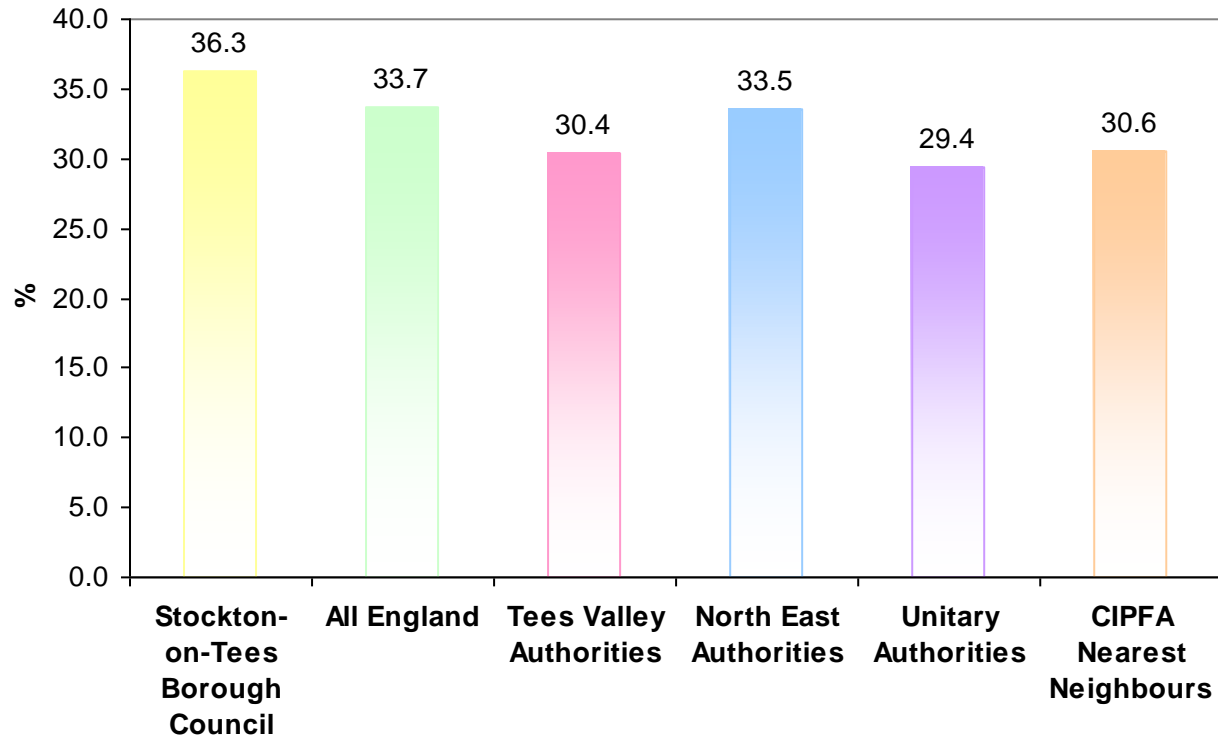

Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with Local Authority Provided Parks and Open Spaces

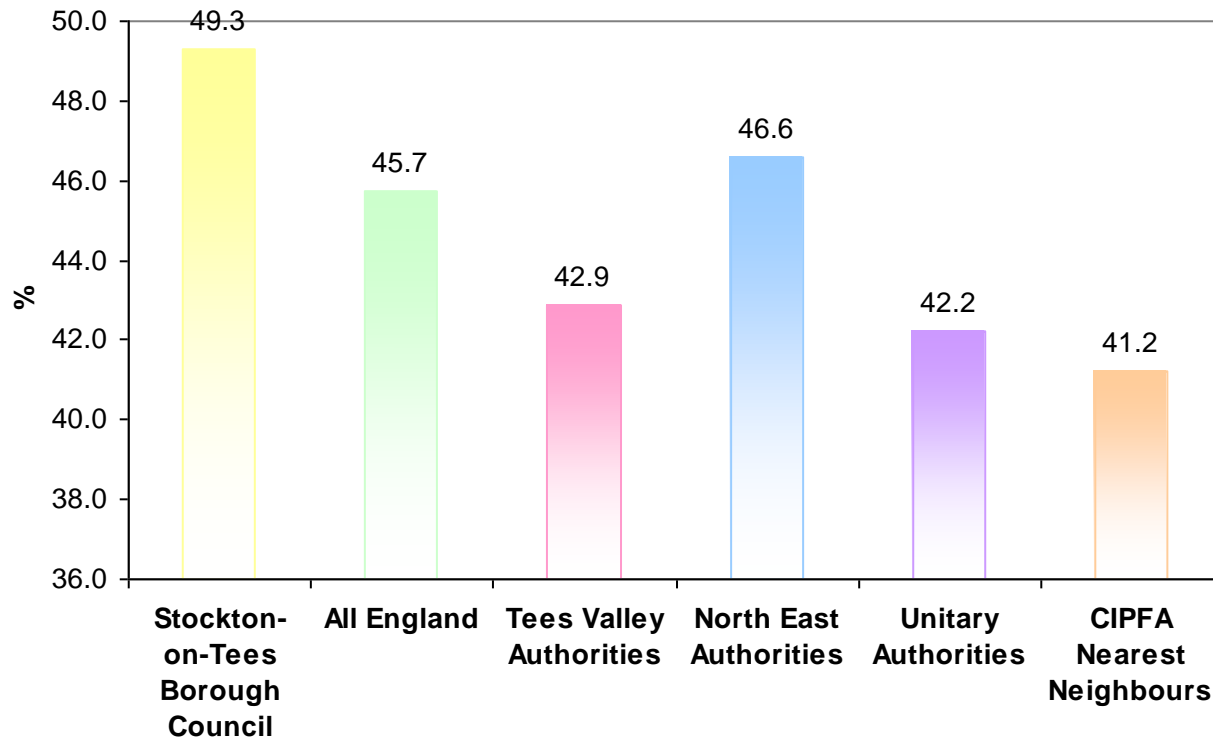

Percentage of Residents that Agree that their Local Council Provides Value for Money

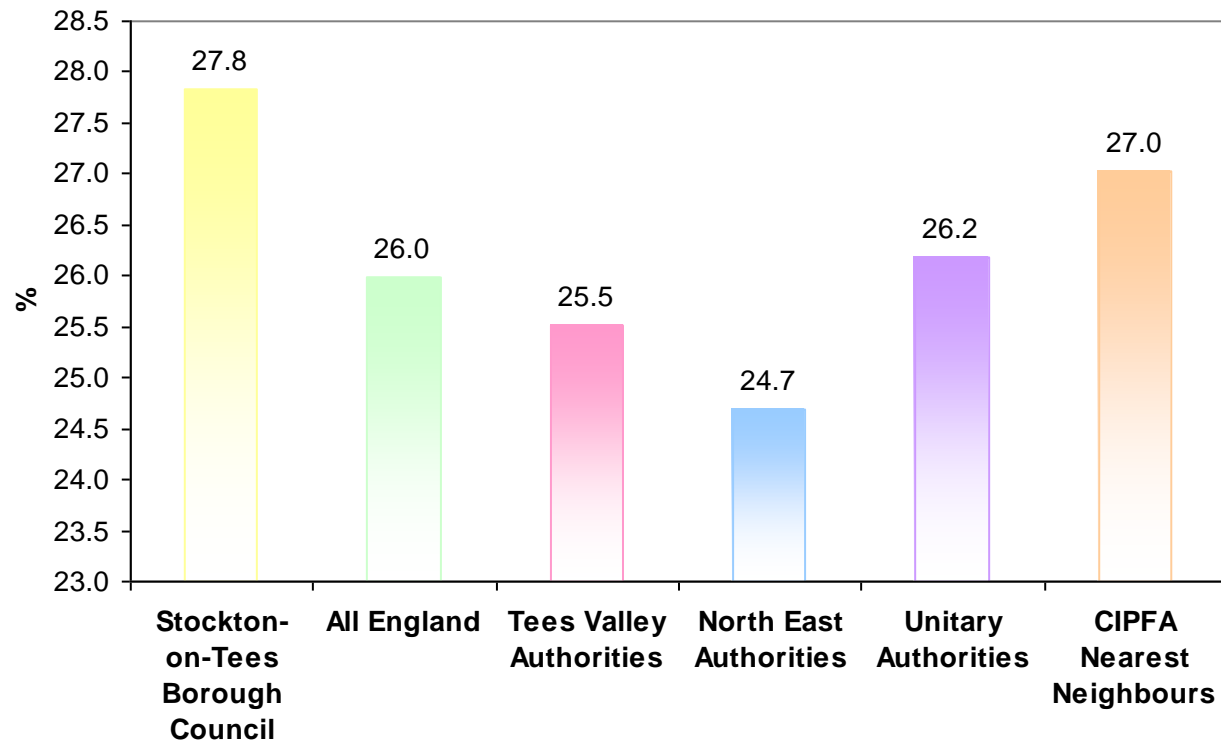


Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with How their Local Council Runs Things

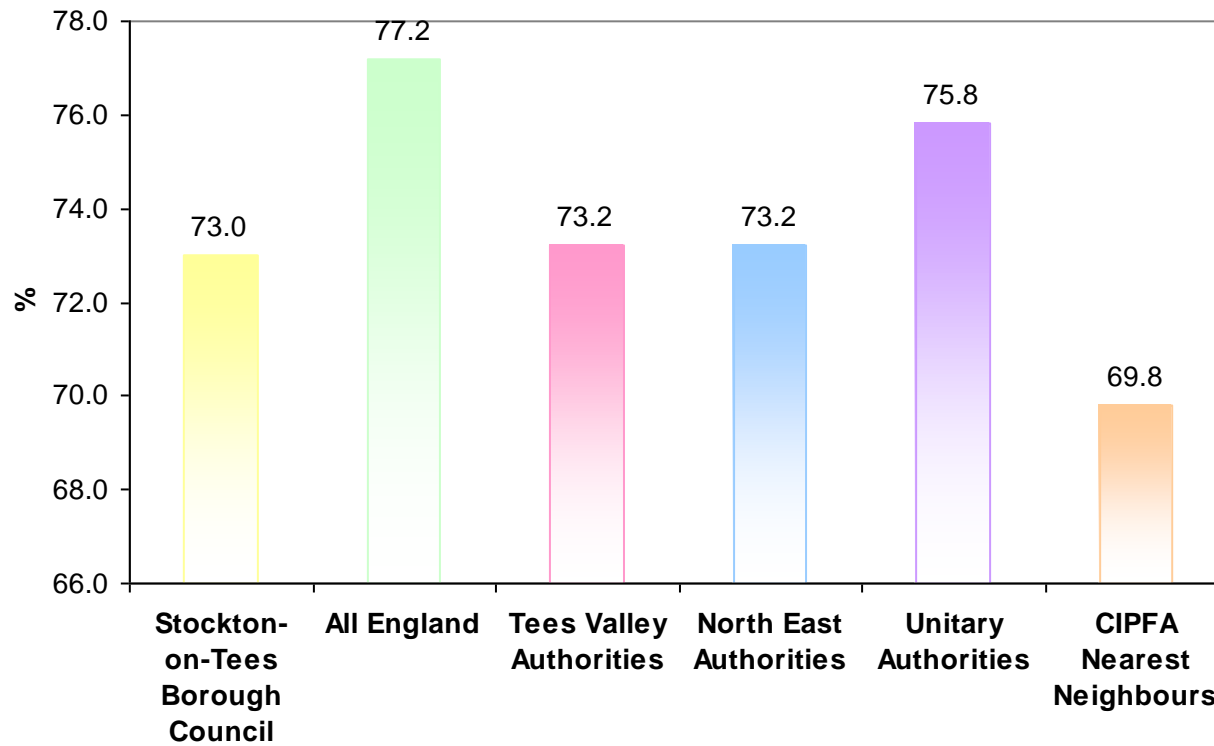

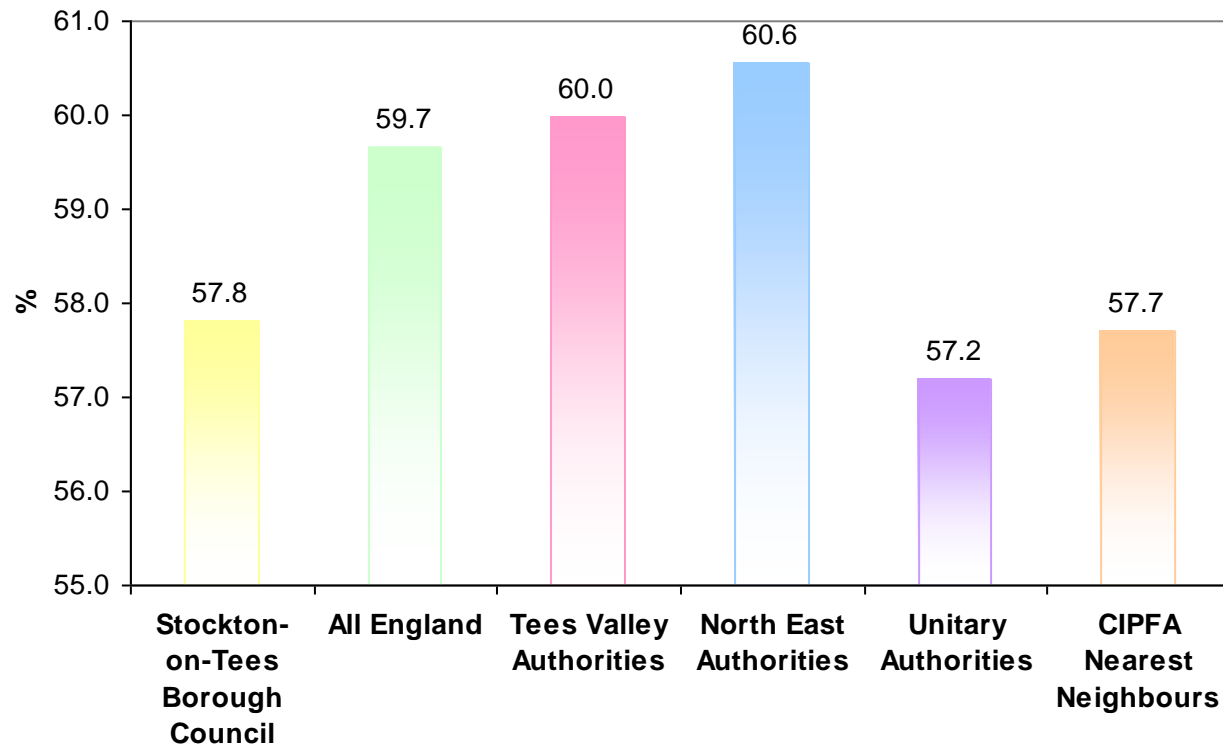
Percentage of Residents who Would Like to be more Involved in Decisions that Affect their Local Area



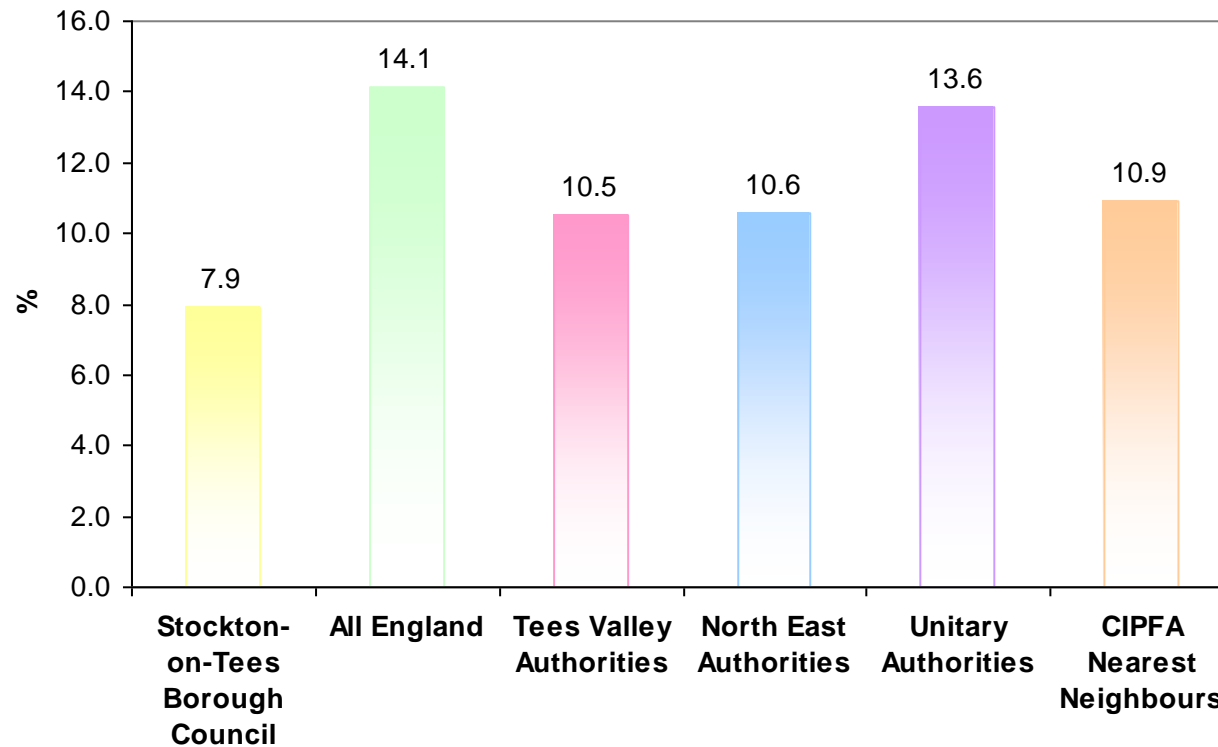
**Percentage of Residents who agree that their Local Area is a Place

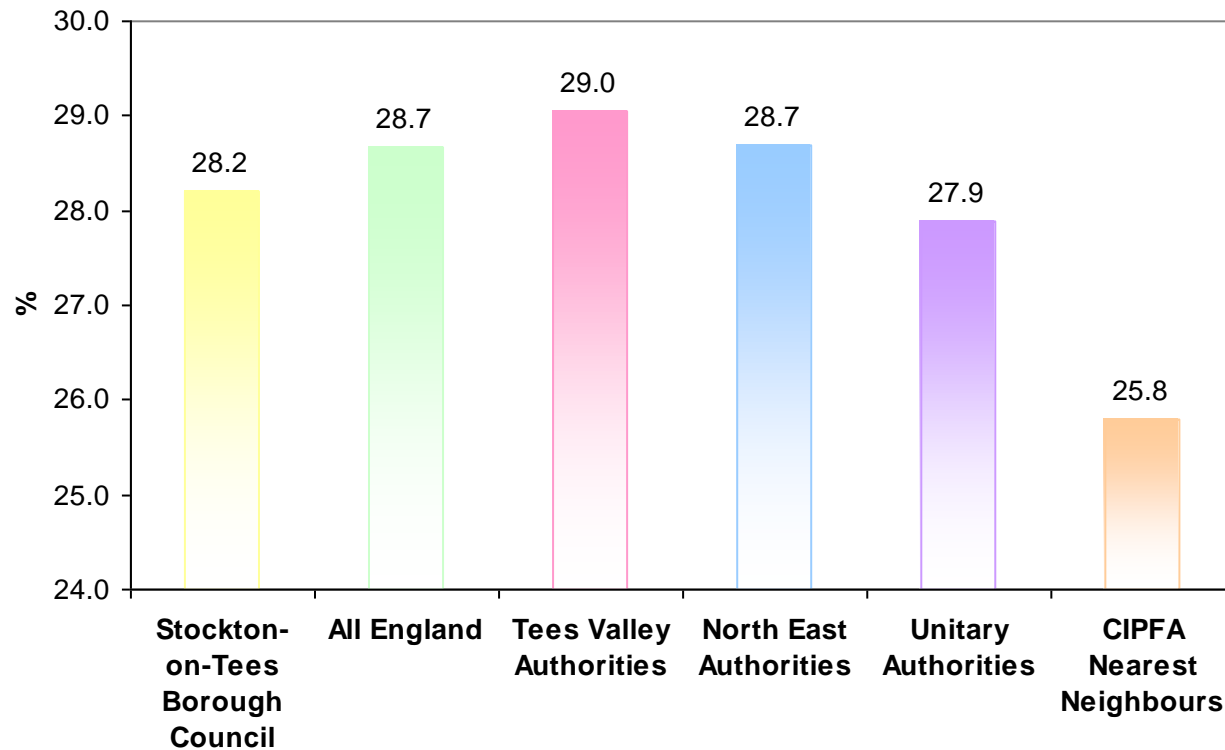
Percentage of Residents who Feel they Belong to their Immediate Neighbourhood (NI 002)



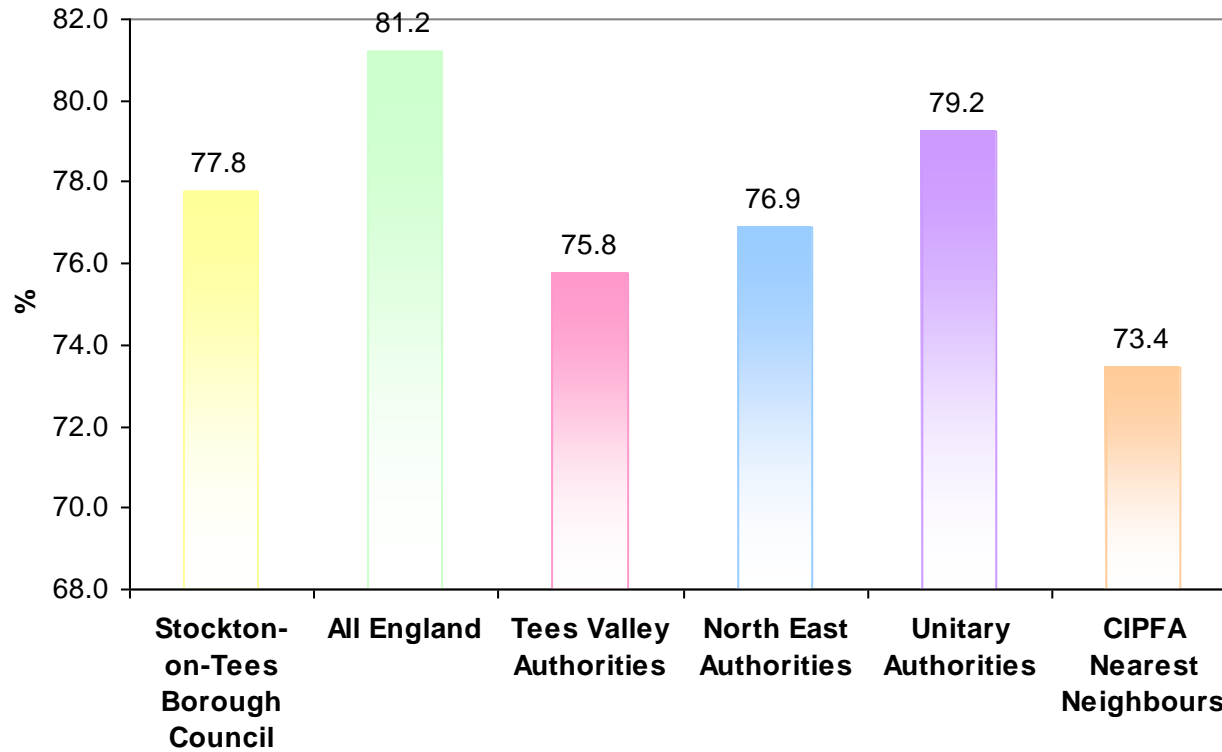
**Percentage of Residents who Have Been Involved in Decisions
that Affect the Local Area in the Past 12 Months (NI 003)**



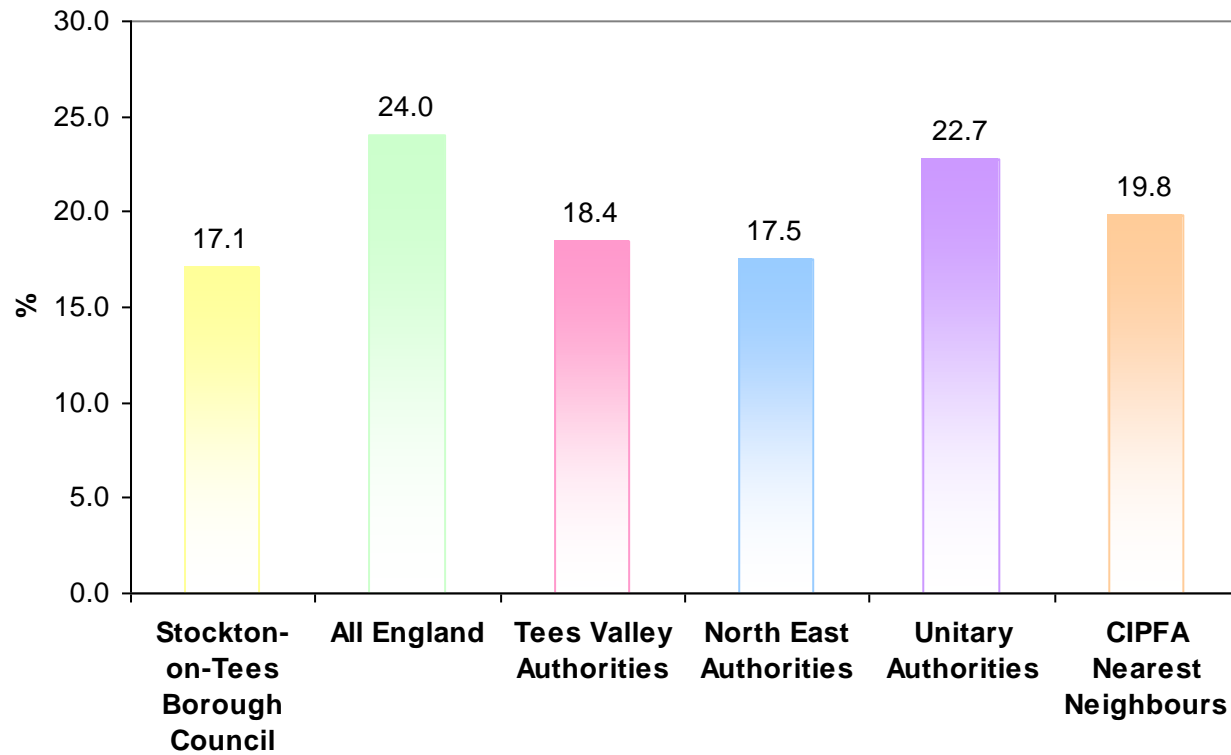
Percentage of Residents who Agree that they can Influence Decisions in their Local Area (NI 004)



Percentage of Residents who are Satisfied with their Local Area as a Place to Live (NI 005)

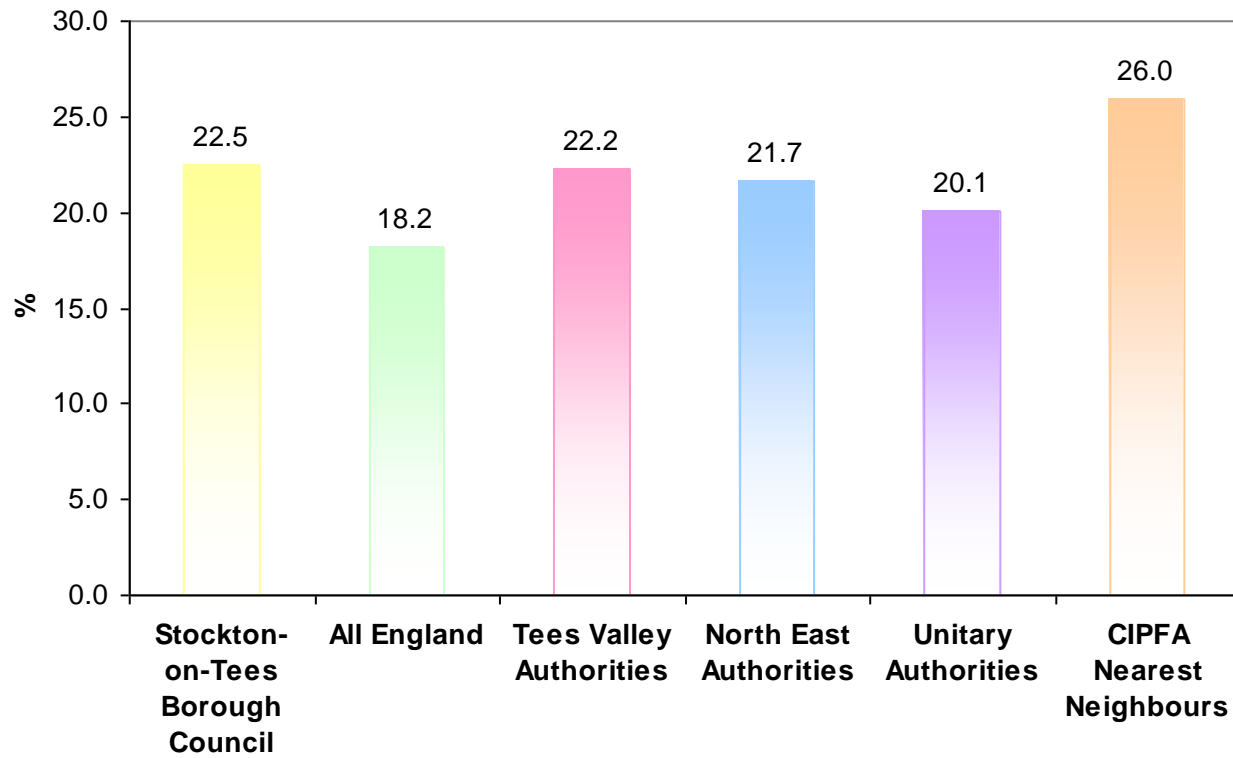


Percentage of Residents Who Have Given Unpaid Help at Least once per Month over the Last 12 Months (NI 006)

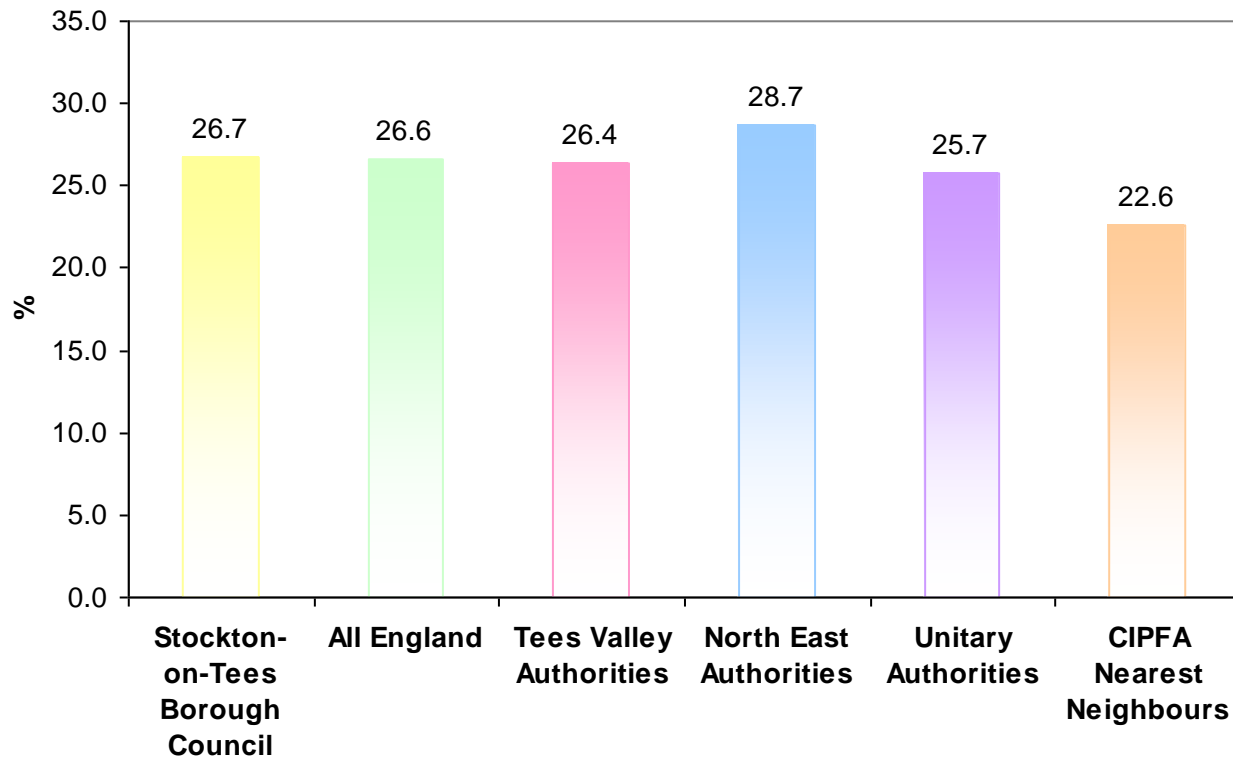

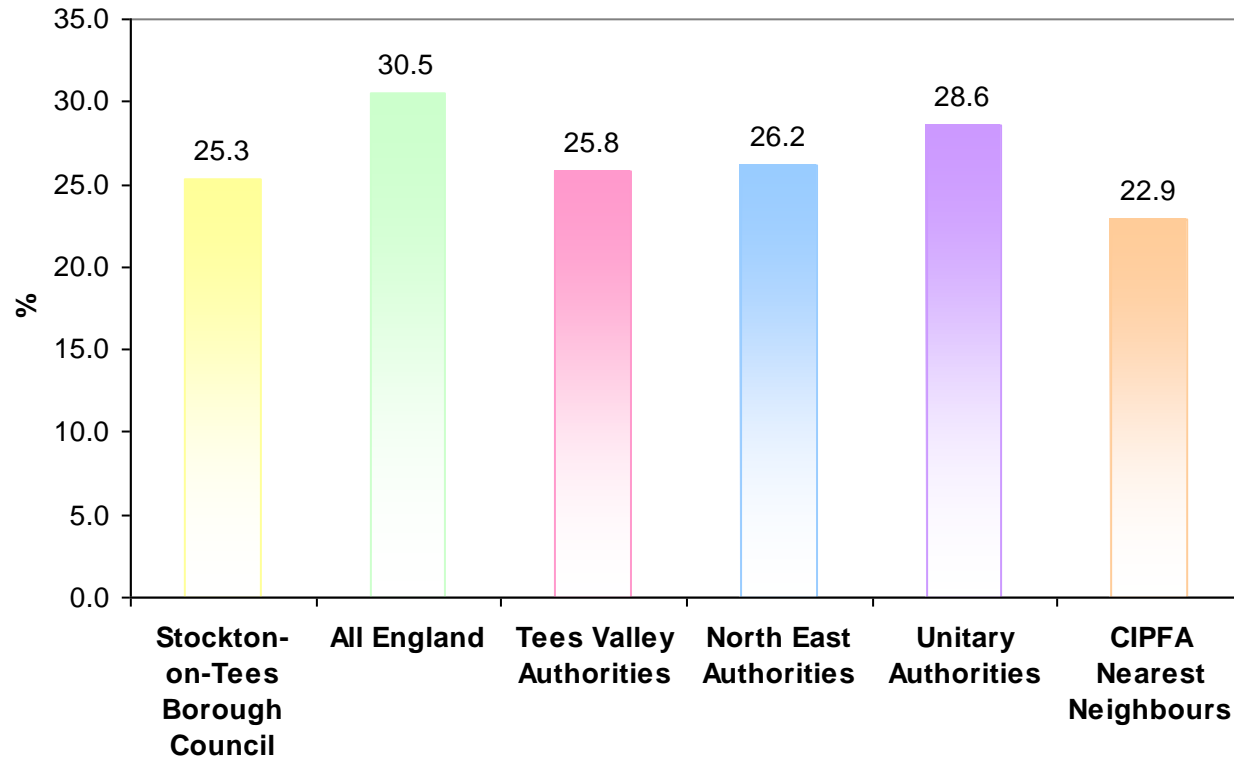
Percentage of Residents Who think that Anti-Social Behaviour is a Problem in their Local Area (NI 017)



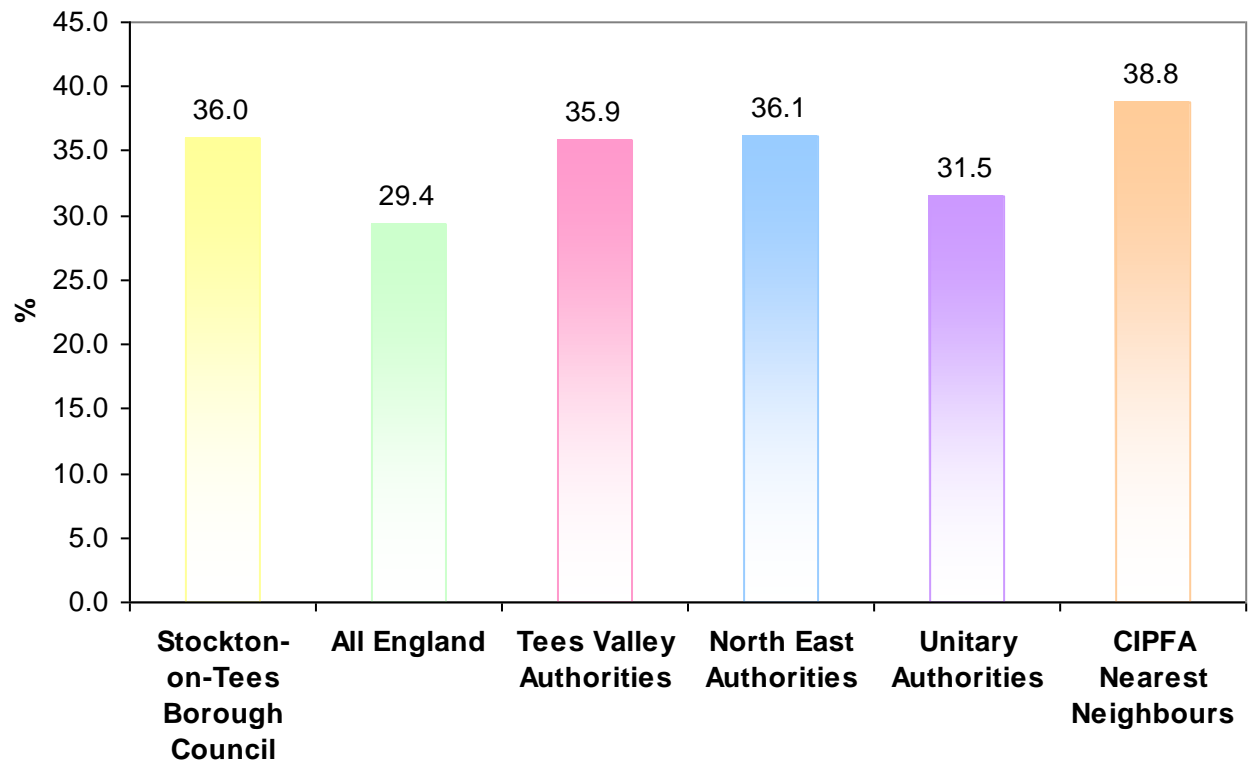

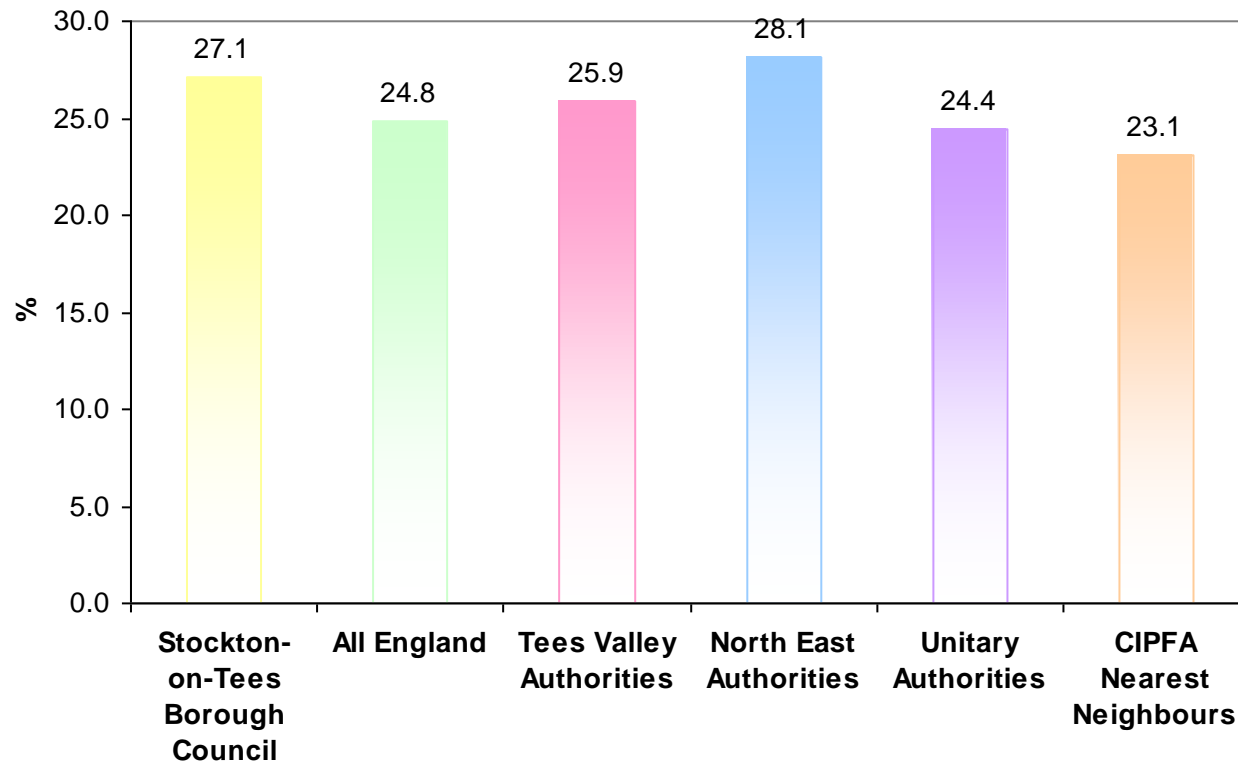
Percentage of Residents Who Agree that in their Local Area Parents take enough responsibility for the Behaviour of their Children (NI 022)



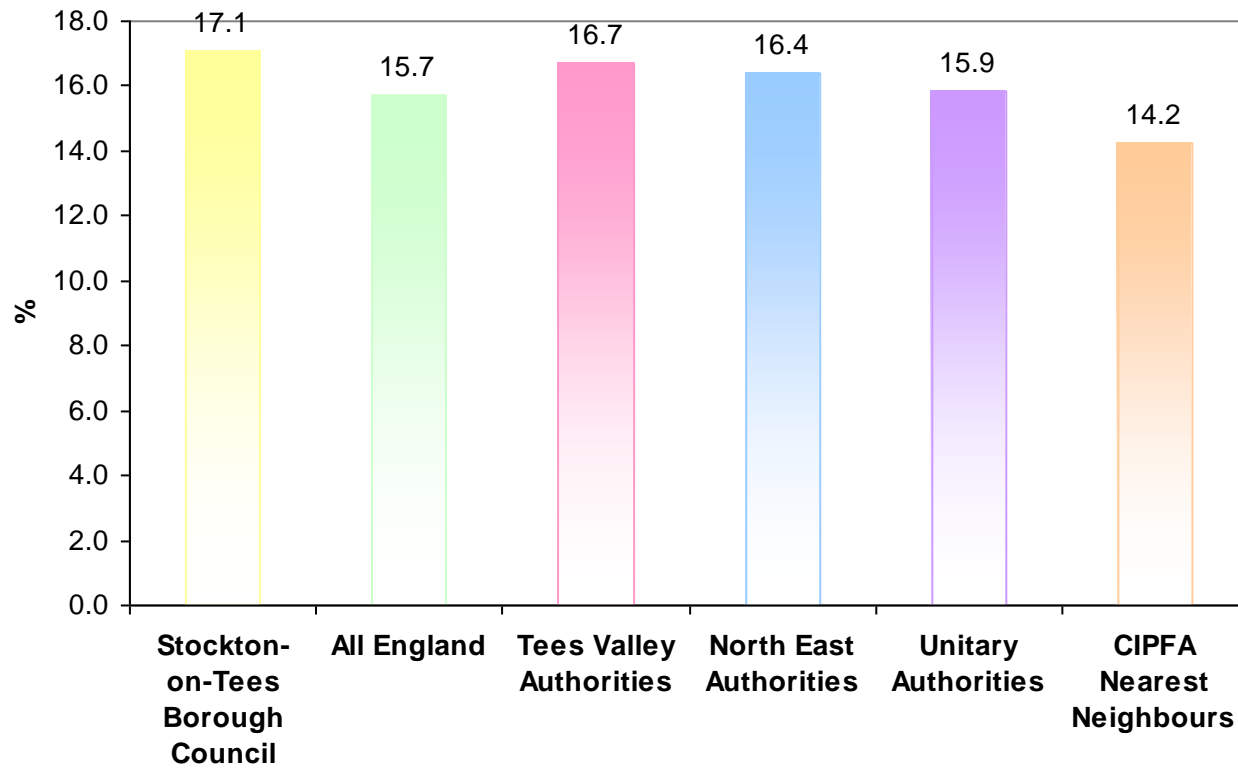
Percentage of Residents Who think there is a Problem with People not Treating each other with Respect and Consideration in their Local Area (NI 023)



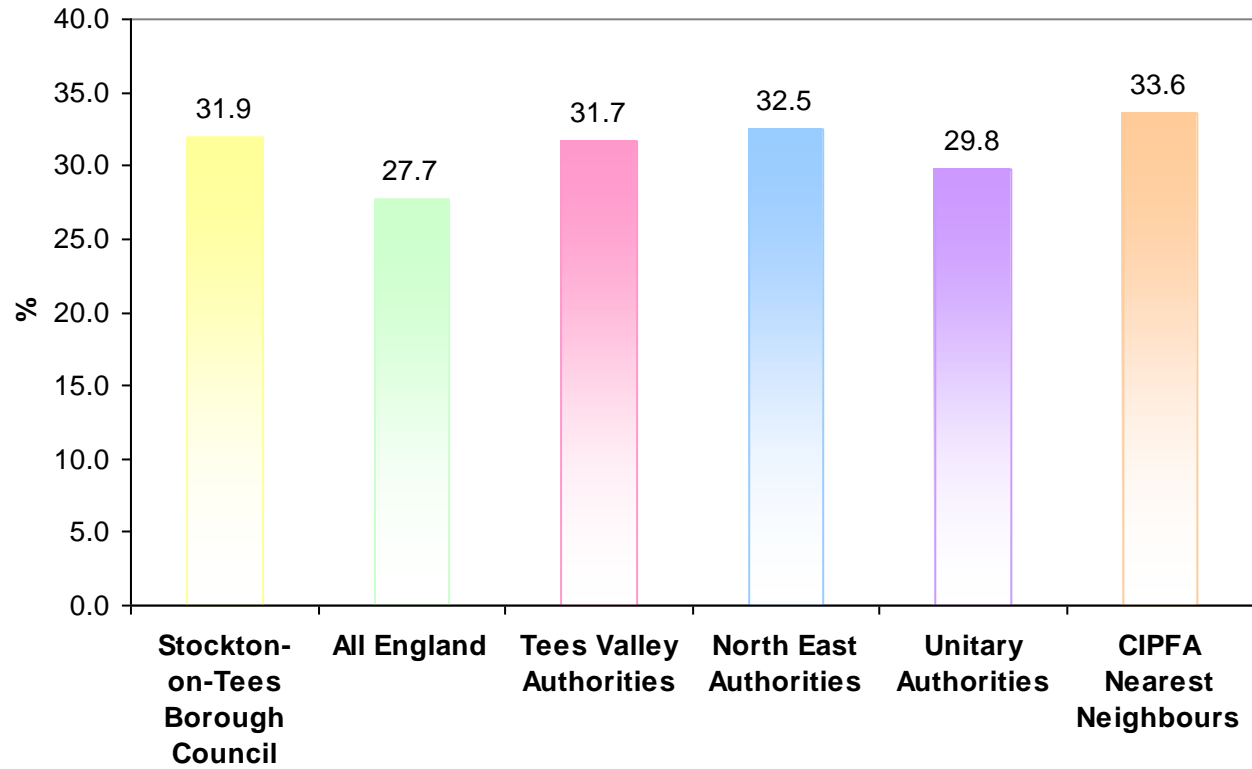

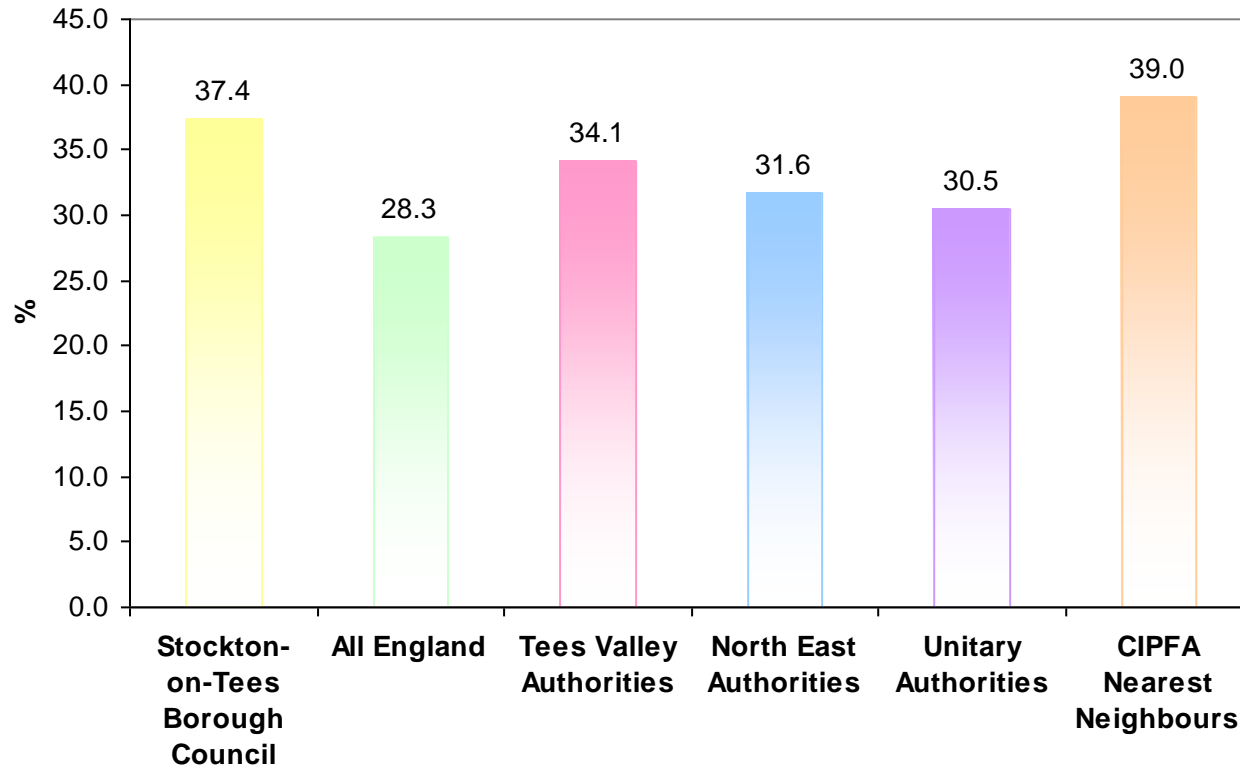
Percentage of Residents Who Feel Informed about What to do in the Event of a Large-Scale Emergency (NI 037)



Percentage of Residents Who think that Drunk and Rowdy Behaviour is a Problem in their Local Area (NI 041)

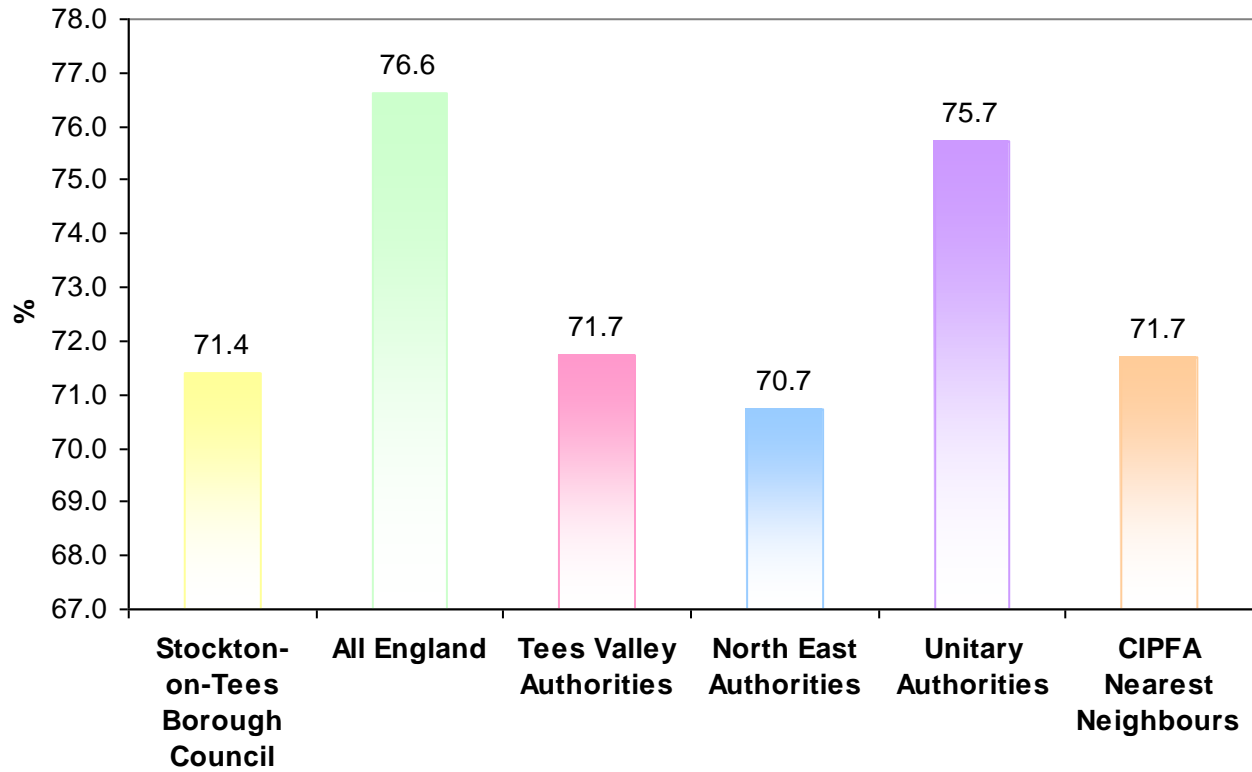


Percentage of Residents Who think that Drug Use or Drug Dealing is a Problem in their Local Area (NI 042)

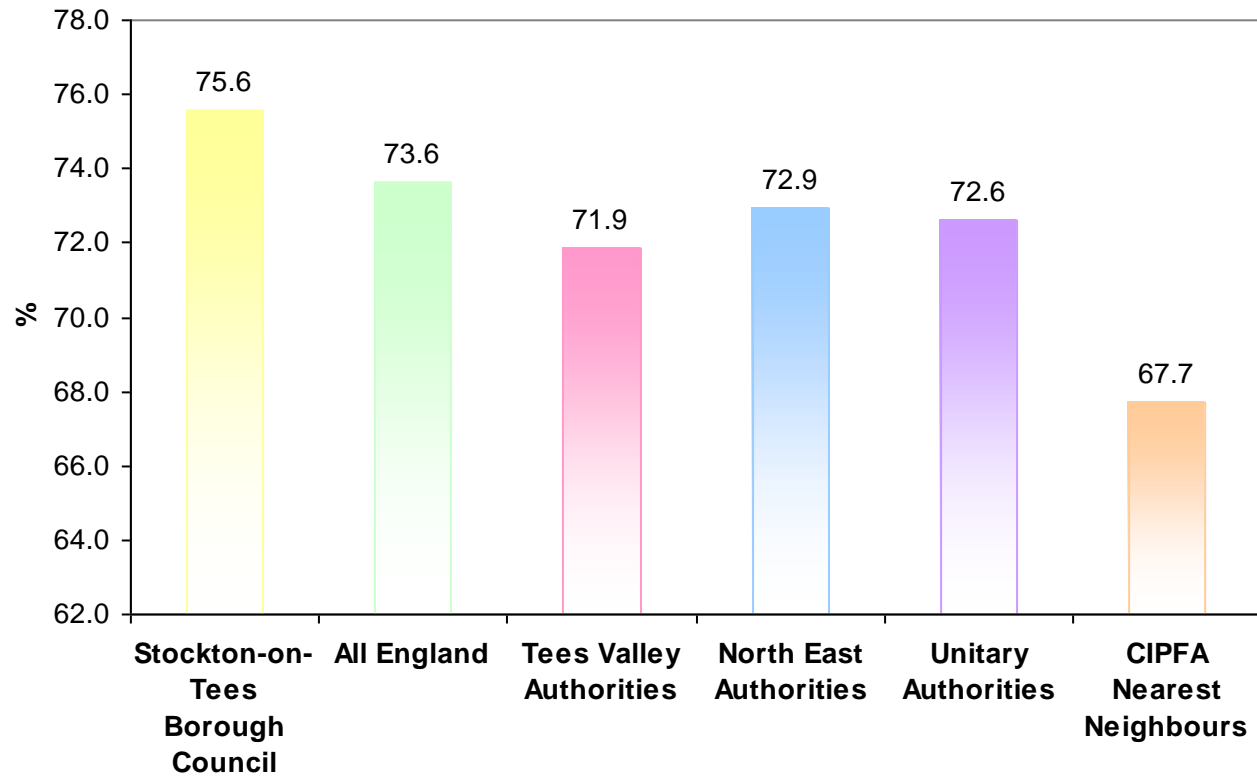

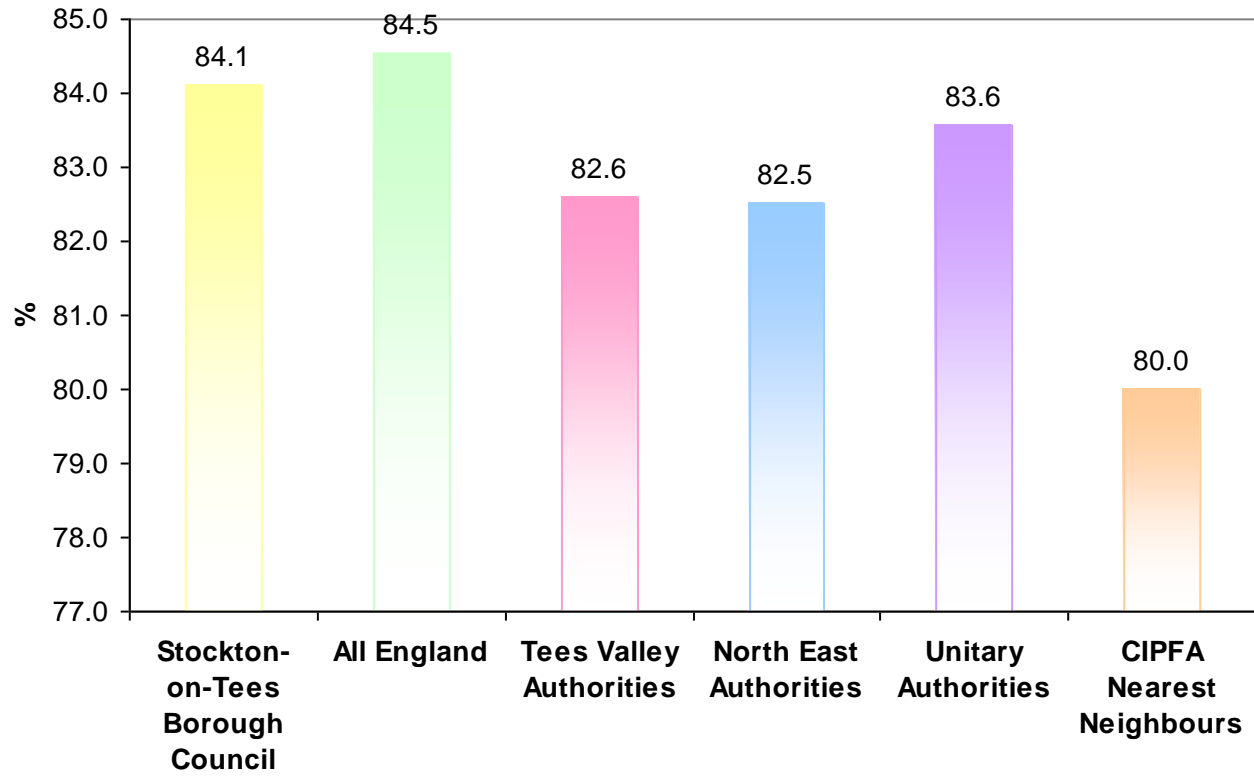


Percentage of Residents who would say that they have been Treated with Respect and Consideration by their Local Public Services in the Last Year (NI 140)
