New executive arrangements – public information programme

The public information programme will be based on:

providing electors with factual information about the referendum
 encouraging people to exercise their democratic right by taking part

- It will be delivered in four distinct phases, of which phases 2 and 3 are detailed here:
 Phase 1 is already complete and surrounded the initial public consultation which took place during September this year.
- Phase 2 takes place during November and early December 2009 and relates to reporting the consultation results to Cabinet and Council, outlining the process and lining up phase 3. Phase 3 will take place during the weeks prior to the referendum itself in February 2010. It will focus on providing factual information on the process for the referendum and the two different
- models, and encouraging participation in the referendum.

 Phase 4 will be developed following the referendum to focus on the communication of the result and information about the implementation of the chosen model.
