1. Title of Item/Report

Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014 – Amendment to the Scheme of Delegation

2. Record of the Decision

Consideration was given to a report that sought approval to amend the Council's scheme of delegation to enable the relevant provisions of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 to be enforced.

The report also sought approval of the fixed penalty fees for non-compliance with a Community Protection Notice and a Public Spaces Protection Order including a maximum fee and discounted fee for early payment.

3. Reasons for the Decision

The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act (2014) provides new powers to local authorities and their partners, and places a number of statutory obligations on councils when responding to incidents of anti-social behaviour (ASB). The key changes outlined in the Act have been discussed at length at the Safer Stockton Partnership and at a Members Policy Briefing in October 2014.
