Asset Review, School Capital and Site Disposal Update	<p>Cabinet will be updated regarding progress in relation to Asset Review, School Capital and Site Disposal.</p> <p>The report summarises progress in implementing recommendations in respect of the Review of Libraries, provides an update on progress around Asset Transfer arrangements and provides recommendations around Site Disposal Strategy.</p> <p>An appendix to the report contains the details of the offers that have been received for the disposal of certain sites that are detailed within the report and is therefore exempt under paragraph 2 and 3 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972.</p> <p>It is considered that deliberation of the matter cannot reasonably be deferred as this will seriously delay the sales and hamper any deals and delay any sales and that it is necessary and appropriate to seek a decision in relation to the matter at Cabinet's meeting on the 12th November, 2015.</p>
