I would also like to complain about the newsletter, it appears to take credit for many matters that I know have been initiated or developed by Stockton Council officers or Voluntary Groups other than the town council. It also states that without the town council a range of services or facilities would be lost, including facilities in John Whitehead Park, this is nonsense and very misleading. I have complained to them before about the increases in the precept but to no avail. I don't know how much this glossy leaflet has cost but the town council was supposed to be low cost, it appears to be run by an empire builder, my opinion.

Community Governance Review – Billingham Town Council

This petition may only have some 2700 signatures but I suspect it would be more if the vast majority of Billingham residents actually stirred themselves to action.

Were most householders to sit down and analyse their Council Tax Bill and its composition I think they would all say let's get rid of a service (and I use the term loosely) that is costing us money each year, however little that is claimed to be. The Borough Council is hard pressed enough making savings and cutting much more important services without having a leeching precept demand from Billingham Town Council every year.

They are providing no real service or added value to what already existed in consultation procedures on council policy. Most of us would rather see even this small amount be put into the overall council pot to ensure more vital services remained in place.

If it was proposed that we return to the days of the old Billingham Urban District Council which had real income and real application then I suspect many older residents would support that. But that is unlikely to happen and as imperfect as the umbrella of Stockton Borough Council is over Billingham, that is what we are stuck with and must work on to improve within the existing structure.

My letter of May 2012 (attached) to the Billingham newsletter still stands in my opinion. I was at one time a councillor for Wolviston Parish Council and although that organisation has some revenue raising capability and the power to spend it within the parish it was still nothing more than a talking shop for some ego trippers. I suspect Billingham Town Council is worse!

So please make the sensible decision to get rid of Billingham Town Council and save us residents some money in these hard pressed times.

- 88. It is our view that Billingham Town Council should not be abolished for the following reasons:
 - It is important that the town of Billingham retains a sense of its own identity, especially within the government body of Stockton-on-Tees
 - The sense of identity fosters community cohesion by an encouragement to residents to be more involved in day to day activities within the town.
 - The efforts that have been made in John Whitehead Park by Stockton Council and Billingham Town Council are to be praised. It is clear that the park is now being used effectively on a daily basis, as originally envisaged.

It is our hope that in time, and through experience, Billingham Town Council will be allowed to take on more governance of the town.

As to the precept; it is to be recognised that some people may find the extra money difficult to justify, especially in times of austerity, however for the reasons stated we feel the cost is value for money.
