Cabinet, at its meeting held on 17th September 2020, recommended to Council approval of the proposed Council Size submission as part of the Local Government Boundary Commission Stockton on Tees Electoral Review 2020. The Commission's decision on council size will not be formalised until the Final Recommendations are agreed and published at the end of August 2021.
