## 2. <u>Record of the Decision</u>

Consideration was given to a report that provided details of the LGSC Ombudsman's annual review letter for the Council for 2021/22. There were 34 enquiries submitted to the Ombudsman during the year, of these 13 met the threshold for a detailed investigation by the Ombudsman. Of the 13 complaint investigations, 5 were upheld. All recommendations made by the Ombudsman, following their investigations, had been implemented. No formal public interest reports had been published.

The annual statistics for 2021, identified the use of the powers available to the Local Authority through the RIPA Act 2000. The Authority returned a zero usage during calendar year 2021.
