## PROGRESS UPDATES ON PREVIOUSLY AGREED RECOMMENDATIONS

## **Summary**

Members are asked to consider the assessments of progress contained within the attached Progress Updates on the implementation of previously agreed recommendations. There are outstanding recommendations from the reviews of Bullying and Obesity.

## Detail

- 1. Following the Cabinet consideration of scrutiny reports, accepted recommendations are then subject to a monitoring process to track their implementation.
- 2. Two main types of report are used. Initially this is by means of Action Plans detailing how services will be taking forward agreed recommendations. This is then followed by a Progress Report at a future agreed date. Evidence is submitted by the relevant department together with an assessment of progress against all recommendations. Should members of the Select Committee agree, those recommendations which have reached an assessment of '1' are then signed off as having been completed.
- 3. In order to track those recommendations which are not signed off following the first round of Progress Reports, a series of Progress Updates are submitted for all Select Committees on a regular basis.
- 4. As discussed at Executive Scrutiny on 27 January 2009, link officers will not normally be in attendance at quarterly Progress Updates following initial progress report, however at the Committees request Gillian McCredie from CESC who has responsibility for implementing the Bullying review will be in attendance at the meeting.
