### Sean's winning performance

**An artistic gymnast from Stockton has returned from the Special Olympic World Games with a host of bronze and silver medals.**

Sean Jewitt, 25, competed in the games in Abu Dhabi which saw athletes from 190 countries compete across two weeks. He was one of six young men selected to represent Great Britain in his category at the games and achieved bronze medals in routines on the bar, pommel horse, vault, parallel bars with a silver for his rings and floor work. He placed bronze overall in his group.

Sean said: "I felt very proud competing and winning medals for Great Britain. I felt amazed! The opening ceremony was very good and I loved making new friends and having fun as well as training."

Sean attends Sporting Steps, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council's sports programme for adults with learning disabilities and mental health conditions. Each week Sean joins the group which meets at Bilingham Forum and Stockton's Queen's Campus. People who are referred to the scheme can enjoy a choice of weekend activities including cycling, walking and football and those involved have reported a boost in fitness, confidence and independence.

Tracy Russell, of the Council's Sporting Steps programme, said: "Sean works really hard and we're delighted that his sporting efforts have been recognised. We are really proud of all that he has achieved and look forward to seeing him reach his goals in the future."

Sean's next competition will be the Great Britain Special Olympics in Liverpool 2021 where he hopes to win even more medals.
