CoPaCC REPORTS FOR APRIL 2013 AND MAY 2013

SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to seek the views of the Panel on the value of the monthly reports prepared by the Confederation of Police and Crime Commissioners.

DETAIL

- The Confederation of Police and Crime Commissioners (CoPaCC)) is one of a number of organisations attempting to represent PCCs collectively.
