APPOINTMENT OF NON-POLITICAL INDEPENDENT MEMBERS

SUMMARY

This report relates to the re-appointment of the Non-Political Independent co-opted members to the Cleveland Police and Crime Panel ("the Panel), under provisions within the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011.

RECOMMENDATION

That Paul McGrath and Luigi Salvati be re-appointed as Non-Political Independent Members to the Panel, with effect from 2 February 2021 until 1 February 2025, and the Home Secretary be notified accordingly.

DETAIL

- 1. The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 requires each Police and Crime Panel to have at least two co-opted members who are not members of one of the local authorities which form the police area.
- The practice of the panel has been to appoint non-political independent members for a term of office of four years. Paul McGrath was appointed on 2 February 2017 for four years and Luigi Salvati was appointed on 10 September 2020 to sit for the remaining period of the vacant seat. Accordingly both appointments will end on 1 February 2021.
- 3. As the next scheduled principal meeting of the Panel is not until 2 February 2021 it is proposed to make the appointments in advance of the meeting and before the terms of office expire.
