- Welfare Rights and the links with Department for Work & Pensions and Stockton & District Advice & Information Service
- Adults with Sensory Loss

The areas put forward by Members for discussion included: -

- Publicity of Leisure facilities/events in the Borough Members were asked provide information on contents of publicity displays throughout the Borough to the Scrutiny Officer.
- Availability of and access to Leisure facilities in the Borough. This included a

- Open Spaces in the Borough
- Billingham International Folklore Festival

The Committee felt that there was a business case for a potential review on Stockton International Riverside Festival including looking at interface with the public, disabled and business in the Town Centre; accommodation and co-ordination with Billingham International Folklore Festival.
