### **1149 Draft Minutes**

The draft minutes of the meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2006 were considered, prior to their submission to Council for approval.

CONCLUDED that the minutes of the meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2005 be forwarded to Council.

### **1150 Work Programme**

The Chairman outlined progress which had been made on establishing the Work Programme for the Adults, Leisure & Cultural Select Committee with the Scrutiny Liaison Forum. The three areas for potential scrutiny reviews, which had evolved from all of the discussions by the Scrutiny Liaison Forum; Adults, Leisure & Cultural Select Committee and the Cabinet Members were: -

- Preston Hall, Park & Museum Strategy
- Performing Arts – Billingham International Folklore Festival/Stockton International Folklore Festival
- River Based Leisure Facilities

The Committee discussed the potential areas for review further.

CONCLUDED that: -

1. A scope for a Scrutiny Review on Preston Hall, Park & Museum be developed.
2. Baseline information be gathered leading up to and during this years Billingham International Folklore Festival and Stockton International Riverside Festival to help identify any possible areas for Scrutiny Review.
