SETTING OF AGGREGATE COUNCIL TAX 2009/10

SUMMARY

To receive details of the Cleveland Police Authority precept and Council Tax, and approve the aggregate Council Tax for the Borough of Stockton on Tees, including all precepts, for 2009/10.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. To note the Police precept of £10,581,206 which equates to a Council Tax of £182.47 at Band D (£121.65 at Band A).
- 2. To approve the aggregate Council Tax for the Borough as set out in the attached Appendix.

DETAIL

- 1. Billing Authorities are required by the Local Government Finance Act 1992 to approve the aggregate Council Tax, including all precepts, for their area. Normally this would have been carried out at the Special Council on 25th February 2009 where the budget and Council Tax for the Borough would be determined together with the Police, Fire and Parish precepts. However, because Cleveland Police Authority are not meeting to set their budget and Council Tax until 26th February this was not possible.
- 2. Details have now been received, and the Police Authority has determined a precept of £10,581,206, £121.65 at Band A (£182.47 at Band D) which equates to a 4.95% increase in Council Tax based on a Band A figure of £115.91 for 2008/09 (£173.87 at Band D).
