### C Mayor's Civic Awards Scheme

The Worshipful the Mayor recognised the achievements of individuals and organisations that had been successfully nominated for a Mayor's Civic Award Scheme.

This was the 4th year of the Awards scheme and new categories of both a Business Award and Health & Wellbeing Award had been added, thereby increasing recognition for the contribution nominees within those categories had made to the community.

The winners had been invited to the meeting and it was the Worshipful the Mayor's great pleasure to present each in turn with a certificate and momento as a thank you for their achievements.

#### -Young Persons Award

The winner of The Young Persons Award went to Young Carers Aloud who won the award for the second time. They were a committed group of young people who worked hard to raise awareness of young carers, and the issues they faced, with teachers, social workers and other professionals. They also campaigned innovatively to make sure young carers were listened to and included in decision making about their families' care and support. As well as their caring roles at home, young people all volunteered their time on a weekly basis to the group.

Representatives from the group were in attendance at the meeting to receive their award.

- The Services to the Community Award-Individuals

The next award was for Services to the Community Award for individuals. The Worshipful the Mayor was delighted to present this award to Reverend Derek Rosamond, vicar of Saint Paul's Church Newtown, Stockton. As well as being an active member of the Stockton Deanery and Stockton Methodist Circuit he served the Borough as a Community Priest representing both Anglican and Methodist denominations on many boards and committees. He was actively involved with many local organisations such as 'Bridge House' and 'A Way Out' and chaired Stockton Town Pastors and the Love Stockton steering group. During the past decade Reverend Rosamond, who was due to retire later in 2015, had worked tirelessly to improve the wellbeing and safety of people in Stockton Borough.

Reverend Derek Rosamond was in attendance at the meeting to receive his award.

- The Services to the Community Award-Organisations

The next award was for Services to the Community Award for organisations and was presented to the team and volunteers behind the Shri Guru Nanak Gurdwara and Sikh Community Centre. The Centre was open to all residents and offerred shelter and food to anyone in need. It provided a wide range of services to the community such as free Punjabi classes, a free kitchen service for homeless and vulnerable people and a weekend crèche to help parents and carers access the centre's services. It also provided respite care for children and young people with complex needs.

-Services to Community Award-Businesses

The next award was presented to Stockton resident Joanna Wake for her efforts to champion Stockton Borough businesses and promote Stockton Town Centre. Joanna ran RAW Digital Training, an independent business based in Stockton Town Centre and employed four people. Through her involvement with Stockton's Town Team, which she chaired, she had been a vociferous and positive advocate for Stockton and worked hard to engage Durham University students, bring in visitors, promote businesses and independent traders.

-Health & Wellbeing Award

The Panel could not separate the two nominations for Health & Wellbeing Award and therefore agreed to have joint winners.

The first was for Glen Johnstone who was the lead volunteer at Our Place Stockton, an out of hours support group for adults. He had worked passionately to help people in the Borough with long term and acute mental health problems, physical and learning disabilities and those facing social exclusion. Those who attended Our Place Stockton said Glen was inspirational and had helped build their confidence and boost their wellbeing.

The other joint winner was Jean Clift who ran the Yarm Association for the Widowed. This vital support group provided a place for widowed people to come together for support and advice. The group ran outings, coffee mornings and exercise sessions, and IT classes to help widowed people tackle feelings of isolation through friendship. A widow herself Jean was committed to helping those dealing with grief overcome their loneliness.

Jean and Glen were in attendance at the meeting to collect their awards.

#### -Green Award

This award was presented to David Saddington and was in recognition for his work globally, nationally and locally to tackle climate change. From a young age, and he was still quite young now, David had been interested in the environment, inspiring other young people at his school and sixth form to get involved. In recent years he had influenced UK government policy, established his own eco social enterprise and fronted a media campaign that reached more than three million people.

David was in attendance at the meeting to collect his award.

-Carer / Foster Carer Award

Last but not least was the Carer / Foster Carer Award which was presented to Angela Stackhouse for being an excellent foster care ambassador. Angela and her husband, John, provided a much needed loving and supportive environment to the children in their care. Angela had high expectations and had been praised for her determination to see the children aspire to be their best. Her work to help the children in her care remain in contact with their birth families was also acknowledged as being excellent.
