The following question has been submitted by Jill Coulter for response by the Cabinet Member for Access, Communities and Community Safety:-

“In light of the most recent police statistics for 118 Darlington road (Red Plains) involving incidences such as criminal damage, anti-social behaviour, hoax calls and violent crime. Please can you confirm if the property is in breach of any of the following laws as highlighted in the document ‘Neighbour nuisance and anti-social behaviour’ compiled by The Local Government Ombudsmen:

- a. Section 1 Crime and Disorder Act 1998 – Anti-social Behaviour Order (ASBO)
- b. Possession proceedings under Housing Act 1996 – breach of tenancy agreement and under ground 2, schedule 2 Housing Act 1985 – nuisance
- c. Section 152(1) Housing Act 1996
- d. Protection from Harassment Act 1997
- e. Sections 79 and 80 Environmental Protection Act 1990
- f. Noise Act 1996
- g. Anti-social Behaviour Act 2003 (ASBA)
- h. Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000 (RIPA)”
