**REPORT OF SENIOR

Proposed Dispensation for Non-Attendance – Councillor Tracey Stott

Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that where a council member fails, throughout a period of six consecutive months, to attend any meeting of the authority then the Member ceases to be a member of the authority, unless the failure was due to some reason approved by the authority before the expiry of that period.

Councillor Tracey Stott is currently incapacitated due to illness and has been unable to attend any meeting of the authority for a period in excess of 5 months. Councillor Tracey Stott is unlikely to be in a position to attend a meeting in the near future and has requested that Council considers granting her a dispensation.

RECOMMENDED that Council considers granting a dispensation to allow Councillor Tracey Stott to remain qualified until such time as she is able to attend a meeting of the Council.
