REPORT OF CORPORATE MANAGEMENT TEAM

Appointments / Amendments to Committees, Joint Bodies and Cleveland Police and Crime Panel

- 1. At its Annual Meeting, held on Wednesday 22 May 2019, the Council approved appointments to its Committees, Panels and Joint/Outside Bodies for 2019/23.
- 2. Members will be aware that the Council is currently holding 3 vacancies and it is anticipated that those vacancies will be filled, following by-elections, to be held in May 2021.
- 3. The vacancies in the Council have created vacancies in a number of its Committees and Panels. Additionally, two members of the Council are no longer members of political groups and are now single, non-grouped, members. As such, they have no automatic right to the seats on Council Committees, that they currently hold. However, Council may allocate seats to those members, if it wishes.
- 4. In order to fill the vacancies and achieve/move toward political proportionality on each Committee involved, a process has been undertaken where the vacant seats have been offered to relevant political groups.
- 5. The outcomes of that process, and the names of the members nominated, are detailed in Table **1**, below.
