### SCRUTINY REVIEW OF BONFIRES ON PUBLIC LAND

# Summary

The third evidence-gathering session for the Committee's review of Bonfires on Public Land will involve contributions from key partners, Cleveland Fire Brigade and Thirteen Housing Group.

#### Detail

- 1. As identified within the scope for this review, Cleveland Fire Brigade has been asked to respond to the following:
  - > Data on locations / prevalence of cases
  - > Resources used to identify / manage cases
  - ➤ Issues / risks around intervention
  - > Advice / guidance published re. bonfires

A presentation addressing the above will be given and is included within these meeting papers.

- 2. Thirteen Housing Group representatives have been asked to provide input regarding their involvement in addressing this issue, including collaboration with tenants / partners.
