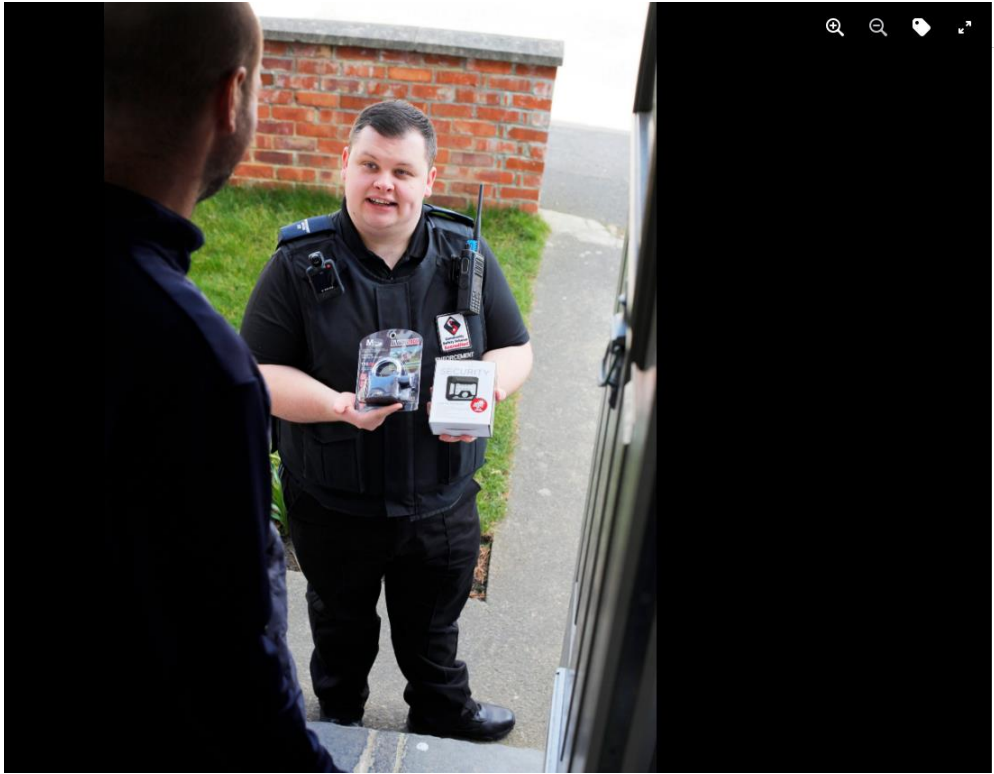

Over the last few days, Stockton Neighbourhood team have recovered two suspected stolen motorcycles and two cars.

The community intelligence led activity was carried out under operation Kickstart.


A blue Yamaha motorbike was recovered from the Tilery area of Stockton, whilst another motorcycle was recovered from Thornaby.

An Audi A3 car was recovered in Billingham after it had reportedly been used without insurance and finally a BMW A1 car was recovered in Billingham, also for having no insurance.

🚒 Vehicles seized in Stockton as part of Neighbourhood Policing Week

Officers from Stockton Neighbourhood Police Team seized three vehicles as part of Operation Kickstart yesterday, Wednesday 19th January. The operation is a proactive operation targeting nuisance and illegal vehicles.



An off-road trail bike was seized from the Norton area for no insurance. Two cars were also seized yesterday, a BMW in Thornaby and a Vauxhall Astra in Stockton Town Centre. Both vehicles were seized for no insurance and the drivers being dealt with for traffic offences. (Pictured)


Two people were also issued with Section 59 notices for nuisance use of quad bikes in Stockton Town Centre.

Also part of Neighbourhood Policing Week, members of Stockton NPT conducted a number of speed watch operations across Stockton and Billingham. This operation targets speeding drivers to educate them and give advice on speed reduction.
