#### ENV Minutes of the meeting held on 13th July 2009

#### ENV Review of Carbon Management

#### 21/09

Members were provided with a presentation identifying the energy consumption and carbon footprint related to Information Technology within Schools and Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Offices.

Members were advised that the purchase of energy efficient equipment was a positive step, however educating users to change behaviour/habits could provide a significant savings for very little financial outlay; such as removal of screen savers which used increased energy and turning off monitors. The most effective reduction of carbon emissions was to not print. Maximising the effects of servers, using energy efficient equipment, video conferencing, electronic agendas and virtual classrooms were also effective ways to increase carbon efficiency.

Officers advised that there were four main components to reducing carbon emissions related to Information Technology and its uses, which were:--Planning and Procurement -Disposal of Equipment -Policy and Procedures -Education

It was identified that a Policy and Practice needed to be developed. Becta would be publishing guidance on saving power and recycling components.

Members were given further information/clarification of 'Building Research

Establishment's Environmental Assessment'(BREEAM)
