1 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

2 Minutes for signature - 16th January 2012

The minutes were signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

AGREED that the minutes be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

3 Draft Minutes - 27th February 2012

Consideration was given to the draft minutes of the meeting held on 27th February 2012.

AGREED that the minutes be approved.

4 Environment Overview

Members were provided with an overview, highlighting the responsibilities, key achievements, current performances and emerging issues of the following service areas:

Discussion took place regarding damage caused by parking on grass verges.

Members noted that parking on grass verges was not illegal, however, if it was proved to be unsafe, or an obstruction, action could be taken. Members were advised that advice should be sought on an individual basis from the relevant officer. A leaflet regarding parking on pavements and grass verges would be circulated to the Committee.

Members discussed litter prevention and recycling and expressed the need for a strategy to promote these issues to young people via schools, particularly in secondary schools.

AGREED that:

2. Officers would circulate leaflets providing more information regarding parking on pavements and grass verges.

5 Update on the Progress of Previous Reviews

Members were provided with further detailed progress of the EIT Reviews of the Built and Natural Environment Service Areas and the Carbon Management Programme.

Members duscussed the new Blue Badge scheme application process. The Committee requested that the process be monitored and that regular advertising take place directing people to the contact centre in Stockton Library, rather than Gloucester House.

The use of tablets at committee meetings and wifi was discussed and it was noted that trials with wifi were taking longer than expected.

AGREED that:

3. Regular advertising be undertaken to direct people to the Contact Centre in Stockton Library for blue badge applications, rather than Gloucester House.
