- Runs from December 2011 – October 2012

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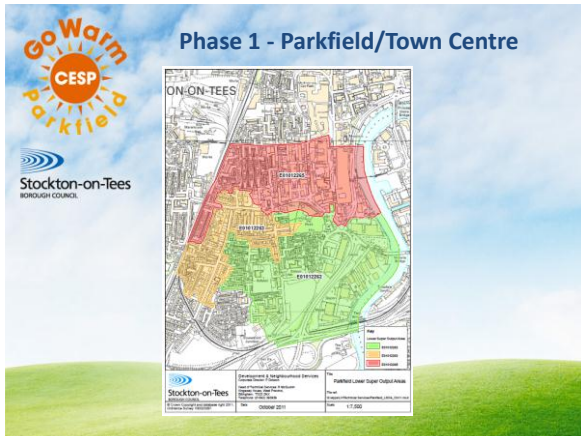

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### How do residents get involved?

they don't need to do anything – an assessor calls at their property

- If they are not in he will leave a card
- residents can call to make an appointment on 01642 605130
- They can also visit the GoWarm Parkfield office at 22 West Row – open from 9am – 4pm



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## Engaging with Private Landlords

- We have written to all landlords in Stockton
- We carry out the assessment and survey as normal
- We then write to the landlord to tell them what we can do – they will NOT need to pay a contribution towards the work
- Once we have their permission we will install the measures
- All guarantees will be sent to the landlord

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## What are the benefits?

- Your house will be warmer and cheaper to heat
- You could save up to £775 a year on your fuel bills
- You will reduce your carbon emissions by as much as 2 tonnes a year
- The work will add value to your property
- The work will improve the look of the area

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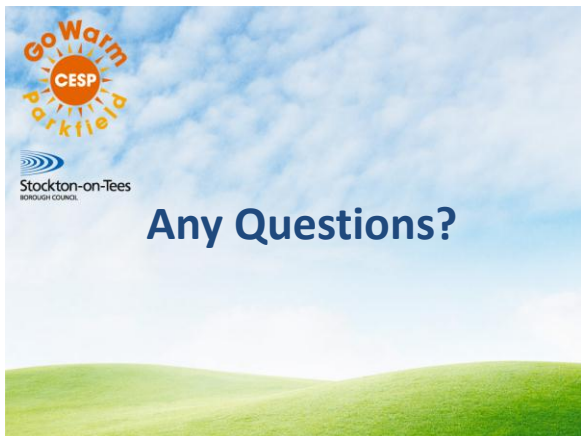
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
