

### Breakdown of Community Safety Audit Cycles

The table below shows the level of responses from the last Five Audit cycles along with a breakdown on priorities. Consistent priorities were Drugs, Violent Crime with the exception of the first which was DV, and ASB (again with the exception of the first Audit).
