Week Commencing 3rd of December ASB Team Patrolled the following ward areas.

Bishopsgarth and Elmtree, Fairfield, Hartburn, Western Parishes, Parkfield and Oxbridge, Newtown, Grangefield, Ingleby Barwick East, Ingleby Barwick West, Mandale and Victoria, Stainsby Hill, Village, Yarm, Eaglescliffe.

Points on Note:

Westbury Street Library - Foot patrol in area of library, support given to library staff on closing. Spoke to group of girls using facilities.

Thorntree Road - Checked shops on Thorntree Road, no youths gathered outside shops or at bus stop.

Thornaby Town Centre - ASB officer's foot patrol carried out in Thornaby town centre – no groups of youths gathering at time of patrol. Spoke to a couple of residents leaving ASDA.

Ingleby Barwick - Mobile patrol of hotspot areas in Ingleby, Beckfields, Myton, Lowefields and Hillbrook Park nothing to report.

Parkfield and Oxbridge – Full mobile patrol of area nothing to report

Medina House Bishopscarth and Elmtree – ASB Offices attended an arranged meeting with local councillors, Police and local residents to discuss problems having with local youths. Camera footage viewed unable to identify any youths.

Rimswell Shops Fairfield - Several youths hanging about outside off license and chip shop. Asked youths to move on as group consisted of more than 5 one youth started to complain when spoken to again he eventually moved on.

Yarm Road/Richardson Road Parkfield and Oxbridge – ASB officer observed youths with alcohol in their possession. One female who is 17 was carrying alcohol which was confiscated from her; a receipt for this was declined. Another youth 15yrs was drinking a can of lager which was taken from him and an AS13 was submitted, also a letter was sent to parents of 15 year old youth informing them of why we had confiscated the alcohol.

Beckfields Shops - Requested by enforcement officer 264 to assist them with removal of youths from shopping area. Spoke to shop staff who stated that several youths had been into the shop shouting and swearing. Requested to look at CCTV, Shop staff unable to work machine.
