Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

The Committee have examined the first annual report on the Service which was produced by the Head of Community Protection, and have also received a presentation on the work of the Service from the Security Services Manager.

During August various consultation exercises have been undertaken. These have included Viewpoint focus group, staff discussion groups, Members going out on patrol with the Service, site visits and an all-Member survey.

The Committee aim to consider this evidence and draft recommendations on 18 September, with a view to agreeing the final report later in the month.
