Review of Tees Active

Update to Executive Scrutiny Committee – 10 June 2008

Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

The Committee considered the scope and project plan for the review of Tees Active at a meeting on 7 May.

The Committee will begin with an overview of Tees Active service provision from Steve Chaytor, Managing Director, on 25 June and will then proceed to take evidence from the PCT, Sport England, Tees Valley Sport. The review will be engaging with user groups and staff members, and looking at the results of existing consultation where they exist.

Members will be holding meetings at the various Tees Active leisure centres during the review, rather than organising a specific site visit.

Timescale for Review

The review of Tees Active is due to report to Cabinet in December.

Monitoring

The Committee will be receiving the Action Plan for the implementation of recommendations from the River Based Leisure Facilities review.

The Committee has no upcoming initial Progress Reports on specific reviews. However, in common with the other Select Committees, the Committee will be receiving a Progress Updates on outstanding recommendations from previous reviews. For ALCS, this will include the Preston Hall and Festivals reviews.
