Reviews of Highway Network Management and Pavement Parking

Chair's Update to Executive Scrutiny Committee – 30 September 2008

Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

At its meeting on 22nd September 2008, the Committee received information on insurance claims made as a result of injury from road or pavement faults together with the results of the recent consultation exercise with Members and Parish and Town Councils on the management of roads and footways within the Borough. The Committee also received for its consideration, a copy of the Help the Aged report 'Falling Short'.

A draft scope of the separate review of Pavement Parking will be considered at a Tripartite meeting on 14th October, being presented to the Committee for final approval.

Timescale for review

The review was initially scheduled to report to Cabinet in November. However, the Committee is looking to report to Cabinet in February 2009, to allow for the review to take into account information and findings regarding highways from this year's Ipsos MORI poll and the results from the review of Pavement Parking.
