EIT Review of Child Placements and Residential Care

Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

Outcomes UK attended a meeting on 11th November to complete stage three of the process. Outcomes UK are carrying out a Collaboration Feasibility Study for Specialist Fostering Service on behalf of the North East Improvement and Efficiency Partnership. They are researching a Sub-Regional Specialist Fostering Service as means of achieving critical mass for specialist services that the majority of local authorities would struggle to achieve in their own right. A total expenditure of approximately £1.5 million over three years would result in a specialist fostering service typically providing 25 concurrent placements and a total cost avoidance of approximately £1.8 million would be realised based upon the cost of external placements. Therefore the service would break even in its third year and realise an overall cost saving of near £0.29 million in this period.
