Update to Executive Scrutiny Committee – 1 June 2010

Review of Built and Natural Environment Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

A tripartite meeting took place on Monday, 10th May. At that meeting limited areas for the EIT review were identified and this was reported back to the Committee at its meeting on Monday, 17th May.

At the meeting Richard McGuckin presented the Committee with a list of budget headings relating to the Council's Built and Natural Environment agenda and it was identified that certain topics had yet to be EIT reviewed. They were:

- The Urban Design Team
- Car Park Charging (including the Blue Badge Scheme)
- Driver training (motorcycle training; SBC Driver Scheme; Driver Improvements)

Another tripartite meeting is to be arranged as Councillor Cook is now the appropriate Cabinet Member (previously Councillor Beaumont).

Monitoring Updates

At its last meeting the Committee received updates for its reviews of Wastes Management and Recycling, and Customer First and requested further information.

At its next meeting the Committee will receive updates for the reviews of cemeteries, and animal welfare/dog fouling.
