EIT Programme

Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

The Committee has started the EIT review of Sport, Leisure and Recreation. The first meeting of this review was held on 19 May. The Committee considered the scope and project plan, and received an overview of the services under review.

At the meetings of 30 June and 21 July, the Committee received the baseline reports in relation to the following services: leisure and sports development, countryside and greenspace, parks and countryside (CYFA), and play.

It was been agreed to re-arrange a meeting for 18 October for the Committee to be able to consider the emerging options.

Timescales

The review is scheduled to report to Cabinet in January 2011.

Monitoring

At the meeting of 30 June, Members considered progress updates on the reviews of EIT Highways, Lighting and Network Management, and River Based Leisure Facilities. At the meeting of 21 July, Members considered progress against the review of Tees Active.
