Update on Progress (including issues/ problems/ successes)

The officer-led Task and Finish Review of Adult Service Structures will be considered by the Committee. The baseline report was considered on 24 January.

Timescales

The Committee is due to consider the preferred options at the meeting of 8 March. The Select Committee will consider the scope of the for the Committee-led review of Mental Health and Learning Disability Services will also be considered at the same meeting.

Monitoring

The FACS Review Action Plan was considered at the meeting of 24 January.

Other Work

A draft PCT/Health Select Committee working agreement has been produced and was considered at the meeting of 10 January.

A presentation from the regional public health team in relation to End of Life Care was provided at an informal session on 2 February, and all Members were invited.

Regional review of the health needs of the ex-service community

Members of the Committee have taken part the in the Socio-Economic Wellbeing Workstream of this project. A wide range of organisations and ex-servicemen have attended the workstream's meetings and provided information on transition, housing and employability.

The group's conclusions were incorporated with the proposals of the other workstreams (Mental Health, and Physical Health). The final report of the project as a whole was considered at a meeting of the Regional Joint Health Scrutiny Committee on 14 January. The report has made a number of recommendations for the region's Councils, NHS and a wide range of other organisations.
