Review of Care for Your Area Services Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

The Committee met on 20 June to agree a scope and project plan for the review and received a pack of base line information for detailed consideration at their next meeting.

The review will be examining:

- Grounds Maintenance
- Kerbside Recycling
- Public Conveniences
- Refuse Collection
- Street Cleansing
- Urban Parks
- Markets Management
- Vehicle Maintenance

The review is projected to report to Cabinet in February 2012.

Forward Programme

The Committee are also due to receive reports on the Officer Led Gateway Review of Waste Disposal and the scope and project plan will be submitted to the Committee at their July meeting. The Committee will then be in position to agree dates for base line and options challenge.
