Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

EIT Review of Commissioned Carers and Independent Living Services

The officer project team is preparing to show the commissioning arrangements for services and cost benefit analysis. This will include:

- A review of where each contract stands when compared within a strategic relevance framework. This work will confirm whether the aims of facilitating independence are met and help in developing longer term commissioning intentions
- An analysis of self assessments undertaken by providers into the value for money that each contract gives
- A similar analysis of the self assessment undertaken by providers into the quality of services provided

Further work has commenced to attempt to show what the outcomes of the services provide in addition to the cost benefits and how people are *actually* benefitting.

At the meeting on 17 January 2012 the draft recommendations will be determined. This means that further slippage of the review timescale will take place.
