Update to Executive Scrutiny Committee – 25 September 2012

Review of Affordable Warmth Update on Progress (including issues/problems/successes)

The Committee met on 10 September and received a presentation from Tristar/Vela Homes regarding their housing stock, including:

- Category 1 Hazard
- SAP ratings
- Measures currently planned to address energy efficiency and affordable warmth

Information regarding the energy efficiency of other Registered Providers housing stock was also circulated.

Members received information regarding Green Deal and Energy Company Obligation, which will be replacing CESP and CERT funding schemes, and the roles Stockton may take in providing these schemes.

The draft Stockton-on-Tees Seasonal Health & Wellbeing Strategy was presented at the meeting, and Members discussed how this strategy could link with and inform the final recommendations of scrutiny review. The Committee believed that clear reporting structures for delivering the strategy needed to be in place.

The final report is scheduled to be presented to Cabinet in February 2013.
