NHS Updates / Consultations Key Issues / Problems or Better Health Programme – This programme of acute services concerns reconfiguration is now a key part of the local Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP). STPs are in the process of being signed off nationally. Public consultation on options is now planned from September 2017. The statutory Joint Committee has been formed by all seven affected Authorities (including North Yorkshire) in order to consider and respond to the consultation. In advance of the formal consultation, the Committee will be reviewing the public feedback to date, plans for consultation, and the development of the options appraisal process. **National Review of Congenital Heart Disease** The new National Review includes services for adults, and the services provided at Newcastle Hospitals Trust. Newcastle will be able to continue to provide CHD services including surgery should they be able to meet the new standards in a given timescale. The Regional Committee has responded on behalf of the region, and as the review would potentially lead to a substantial variation to local health services, Council agreed Stockton's element of the response on 3 May. Stockton Health Centre (Tithebarn) Registered Patient GP Service ASH Committee considered the proposal for the retention of a part-time service in April, and as a substantial variation to local health services, the Council agreed the consultation response on 3 May.
