<b>Overview / Performance and Quality Assurance</b>	
<b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b>	<p><b>North Tees and Hartlepool (NTH) NHS Trust Quality Account -</b> The Trust presented the draft Quality Account for 2016-17 in April. This includes priorities for improvement and a record of performance in the previous year. The Committee has submitted its statement of assurance for inclusion in the published version.</p> <p><b>Quality Standards Framework (QSF) -</b> The dates for next year's round of results are being finalised.</p> <p><b>Quarterly Round-up of CQC Reports –</b> Q4 2016-17 was considered in April.</p>
<b>Requests for more information</b>	Medication continued to be a theme in care home CQC reports and Members were informed the QSF process was being amended to reflect this.

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NHS Updates / Consultations	
<p><b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b></p>	<p><b>Better Health Programme</b> –This programme of acute services reconfiguration is now a key part of the local Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP). STPs are in the process of being signed off nationally. Public consultation on options is now planned from September 2017.</p> <p>The statutory Joint Committee has been formed by all seven affected Authorities (including North Yorkshire) in order to consider and respond to the consultation. In advance of the formal consultation, the Committee will be reviewing the public feedback to date, plans for consultation, and the development of the options appraisal process.</p> <p><b>National Review of Congenital Heart Disease</b></p> <p>The new National Review includes services for adults, and the services provided at Newcastle Hospitals Trust. Newcastle will be able to continue to provide CHD services including surgery should they be able to meet the new standards in a given timescale.</p> <p>The Regional Committee has responded on behalf of the region, and as the review would potentially lead to a substantial variation to local health services, Council agreed Stockton's element of the response on 3 May.</p> <p><b>Stockton Health Centre (Tithebarn) Registered Patient GP Service</b></p> <p>ASH Committee considered the proposal for the retention of a part-time service in April, and as a substantial variation to local health services, the Council agreed the consultation response on 3 May.</p> <p>The CCG's final decision is expected on 16 May.</p>
<p><b>Requests for more information</b></p>	<p><b>Better Health Programme</b>- In March, the Committee considered information on the level of local authority involvement in the development of proposals, and the plans for the public consultation process.</p>

<p><b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b></p>	<p><b>Tees Valley Committee</b> – Middlesbrough Council are hosting during 2016-17. The meeting on 26 April received an update on engagement feedback as part of the review of NHS funded respite care for people with learning disabilities, the regular NEAS update, and TEVV Foundation Trust's Quality Account and performance update.</p> <p><b>Regional Committee</b> – The Committee met on 2 March and considered an update from NEAS and its Quality Account, and the</p>

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	national review of CHD services as noted above.
<b>Requests for more information</b>	The Committee will be updated with the Vascular Surgery review and formal consultation is planned (it is not currently foreseen that this will affect patient flows for Stockton residents).
